The meaning of visual and sound signals are stated below．An arrow pointing up or down（T）means that a
visual signal is displayed or removed．A dot（0）means a sound；five short dashes（－ issual signar is displayed or removed．A dot（ $\bullet$ ）means a sound；five short dashes $(-\cdots--)$ means repeti－
tive sounds a long dash $(-)$ means a long sound．When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag，the signal applies only to that class．
