

LOW COUNTRY HOOK OCEAN RACE

Hilton Head, SC to Skidaway Island, GA 25-26 August 2023



NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authorities of the Low Country Hook Ocean Race are the Chatham Sailing Club (CSC) and The South Carolina Yacht Club (SYYC)



1. RULES

1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to monohull sailboats with a length minimum of 22 ft. and a maximum of 51 ft. All eligible boats must have a PHRF rating, have auxiliary power, VHF radio and be manned by an eligible captain and crew.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form available at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26366 together with the required fee by 25 August 2023.
- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted by the race committee but will not be eligible for early registration discount.
- 2.4 There will be separate classes for Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and Cruising (roller furling main and fixed blade propeller, or as determined by the race committee). A One Design class may be included if 5 or more boats register as the same One Design (ex. J/24).

3. OTHER RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 All boats shall carry an operating VHF radio.
- 3.2 All boats shall be sailed by at least two persons.
- 3.3 At all times, boats shall monitor and keep clear of commercial traffic.
- 3.4 The US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for category Nearshore are suggested.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The early registration entry fee is \$125 per boat. The registration fee includes 1 commemorative shirt and two dinner tickets for the closing ceremony at Landings Harbor Marina.
- 4.2 Late registration fee of \$15 is applied for entries received after August 19, 2023.
- 4.3 Registrations are non-refundable after August 25, 2023.
- 4.4 Participants will make their own arrangements for Dockage on August 25 and 26.
- 4.5 To order the event shirt, send \$25/shirt via Zelle to chathamsailclub@gmail.com or Venmo to @chathamsailclub. In the payment description, specify the event and shirt size. If multiple shirts are ordered, include the detail in the payment description. We'll notify you when the event t-shirts are ready and arrange for pick up. Note: Hook Race shirt orders must be submitted by July 22, 2023. Click here for the Venmo link to Chatham Sailing Club.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Starting times are approximate and will be finalized in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2 Date Time Description

Competitors arrive at the Race Marina (location TBC)

6:00PM Competitors meeting at the Race Marina. Location to be indicated in the Sailing Instructions **08/26** (Saturday)

9:55AM Warning signal for first class

3-5 PM Dockside Bar Party at Landings Harbor Marina to welcome race competitors at finish line.

7:00PM Time limit expires

7:00PM (or ASAP after last boat finishes) Race Results & Awards published via email. Awards will be mailed to winners not in attendance at Closing Ceremony.

5:30 – 7:30PM Closing Ceremony & Dinner at Landings Harbor Marina

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available on, or before, August 20, 2023 and at the skippers meeting August 25, 2023 via a link to Regatta Network. https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26366

7. VENUE AND COURSE

- 7.1 The race area will include the Calibogue Sound, Atlantic Ocean, Wassaw Sound, and the Wilmington River.
- 7.2 The event will consist of one race from Hilton Head Island to Skidaway Island.
- 7.3 The race course will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

8.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. The VHF Hailing Channel 71 will be used for race committee communications to competitors.

9. SCORING AND PRIZES

- 9.1 Awards for each class will be given to first, second and third places. Awards may be mailed to the participant. There will also be a Hook Prize for the best corrected time in all PHRF classes.
- 9.2 PHRF ratings for boats without a valid or previous PHRF certificate will be assigned by the race committee. Time allowances will be calculated based on time on time scoring.

10. DOCKAGE

- 10.1 Arranging for necessary dockage is the responsibility of the participant.
- 10.2 Overnight dockage will be available at a marina between the start line and Windmill Harbor, location TBC. Rates will be similar to past years, regardless of boat size and including power and use of amenities. Skippers must reference the event when calling to make a reservation. Reservations with credit cards & cancellation of less than 72 hrs. will result in full charge. Check in will be after 3 PM.
- 10.3 Overnight dockage at **Windmill Harbor** (South Carolina Yacht Club) on Hilton Head will be available at no charge based on space available. Contact Mark Newman, (843) 342-2628, mnewman@scyachtclub.com
- 10.4 Overnight dockage in the Landings Harbor Marina Basin is not available (no open slips).
- 10.5 Overnight dockage in the **Savannah Yacht Club** will be available at no charge based on space available. Dockage must be reserved with SYC's Dockmaster @ 912-897-1314. Dockage may also be found by inquiring at other local marinas on the Wilmington River, Skidaway River and Turners Creek.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. It is the competitor's decision to enter, start or continue in the race. Competitors' attention is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 3 which states: 'DECISION TO RACE The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.' As a condition of their participation in this race, competitors release all claims they may have against Chatham Sailing Club and The South Carolina Yacht Club (Organizing Authorities) and their officers, directors, members, committees and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race. Competitors shall be responsible for damage or injury caused by their breach of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* or applicable government rules for the avoidance of collision.

12. INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance sufficient to cover liability for loss, damage, personal injury or death.

13. CANCELLATION OF RACE

13.1 Safety of Boats and Competitors is a top priority. The Race Committee and PRO will assess the weather before starting the race and will determine delays, course changes, postponement, and cancellation.
