North Flathead Yacht Club is pleased to announce the 46th Annual Montana Cup Regatta Come enjoy two days of racing and camaraderie at one of the best places to sail in the Northwest.

Enjoy time with friends both old and new in one of the most beautiful settings available. We will have dinner and music on the lawn Saturday Evening, lawn games, breakfast on Saturday and Sunday, and stories by the fire.

Once again, in addition to the PHRF and One Design Fleets, we will be having a Cruising Fleet which will race in one long distance race each day. For those who have participated the last couple years, they have found it to be a wonderful weekend of laid back racing.

The Montana Cup Regatta & State Sailing Championships was established by the Canyon Ferry Yacht Club in 1977 for the purpose of promoting and recognizing team racing in Montana, the Regatta now draws competitors from across the State & the Greater Pacific Northwest region.

North Flathead Yacht Club is committed to hosting a green regatta and we have some reusable utensils, but supply is limited; please bring your own dishes, cups and water bottles.

The Corinthian spirit is alive and well in Montana. Please do your part to be courteous to other racers, NFYC Race committee, and grounds. To get to the club from downtown Somers, turn south at Del's Bar and follow Leslie Avenue past the VFD and Classic Company Boatworks. Keep going through the gates –marked NFYC--and horsepasture. You'll find us hidden at the end of the road.

If you are transporting a boat from out of the area please ensure that it is thoroughly cleaned, drained, and dried, and be sure to stop at all watercraft check stations. Due to the heightened threat of Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS), visitors must now document AIS Inspection clearance as a prerequisite for Regatta Eligibility and use of NFYC launch and dock facilities. For questions, please refer to https://fwp.mt.gov/conservation/aquatic-invasive-species. DO NOT LAUNCH prior to showing proof of clearance.

Upon your arrival, please check in with Port Captain or representative, for slip and trailer assignments, you may then be directed toward registration, the mast lift, the trailer extension, and an appropriate launch ramp.

On-site camping is encouraged during the Regatta, although a variety of accommodations can be found within a few minutes' drive. Club amenities include shaded picnic areas, covered grilling and dining areas, sinks, ice, Wi-Fi, fire pit, and restrooms with showers. If you plan to come early or stay late, which I strongly recommend, we will attempt to accommodate you and your boat. Pets are discouraged during this regatta.

NOTICE OF RACE

1 HOST CLUB

1.1 North Flathead Yacht Club, Somers, Montana will be the host club and organizing authority for the Montana Sailing Championship.

2 RULES

- **2.1** The regatta will be governed by the current US Sailing: Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024
- **2.2** Prescriptions of PHRF, the Sailing Instructions and all amendments thereto, will apply.
- **2.3** A. The host club organizes registered boats into fleets based on handicaps.
 - B. The Montana Cup shall be governed by the PHRF of the Northern Rockies. Boats without
 - ratings shall contact the host club and will be assigned a base rating. C. Specifications and measurements may be required to assign the base rating. Any adjustments will require a completed <u>measurement form</u>.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to all displacement and non-displacement boats.
- **3.2** There may be up to five fleets for displacement boats and one fleet for non-displacement boats. There may be multiple cruising class fleets.
- Fleets will be determined by quantity and type of yachts entered. Fleets with a minimum of five one-design boats registered may be given their own start and fleet at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- **3.4** Eligible boats may enter by going to the NFYC website www.nfyc.org and following the link for Montana Cup online registration.
- Late entries will be accepted at a higher fee until 7PM the Friday, August 4th 2023.

NOTICE OF RACE

The Montana Cup shall be governed by the PHRF of the Northern Rockies. Boats without ratings shall contact North Flathead Yacht Club and will be assigned a base rating. Specifications and measurements may be required to assign the base rating. Any adjustments will require a completed measurement form.

North Flathead Yacht Club boats are assigned moorage at the North Flathead Yacht Club docks. Visiting boats shall be assigned a slip by the Port Captain if requested and shall stay in the assigned moorage. Smaller boats may be stored on a trailer in an assigned location in the lot.

NOTICE OF RACE

One completed race constitutes a series. When fewer than Six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. For fleets completing Six or more races, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. Scores for Disqualification are not excludable. Thistles class will be scored with no throw outs, all races will count.

12 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each fleet. The MontanaCup will be awarded to the club with the total highest point per the Montana Cup Deed of Gift.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000. Proof of insurance may be required.
