



# Outlook Trophy Sunday, August 27, 2023 ASMBYC High Point

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Organizing Authority is South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club (SCCYC), 13444 Bali Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292. This is a 13+ mile pursuit race; each boat will be assigned a start time expressed in minutes after the slowest-rated boat starts. The assigned start time is calculated by the Race Chair and is based on the boats' random leg PHRF ratings or in limited cases Portsmouth Rating (D-PN) converted to a PHRF rating by the race committee.

#### RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is modified to require all competitors sailing boats of less than 20 feet LOA to wear personal floatation at all times except for short periods while changing clothes.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

- 2.1 The race is open to all boats with a PHRF rating of 263 or less or a D-PN =less than 104.
- 2.2 Boats need to conform to class rules, including minimum and maximum crew weights and number of crew.

#### 3. ENTRY AND FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$20.
- 3.2 Entries must be made online through <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> by 0900, the day of the race. Competitors must provide a mobile number and tick the box to allow text messages from the organizer; this will be used to communicate start time or postponements. Competitors under the age of eighteen must have their entry signed by their parents or guardian.

#### 4. CLASSES

- 4.1 Classes are mono-hull centerboards (20 feet and under), multi-hulls (20 feet and under) and keel boats.
- 4.2 Three or more one-design boats will establish a one-design class.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> and <u>www.sccyc.org</u> web sites no later than 2000 hours on the Friday before the race.

#### 7. SKIPPERS MEETING

There will be no skippers' meeting. Starting times will be assigned and communicated via text, and posted on the SCCYC website before 1000 the day of the race. Registrants must, upon registering for the event be sure to tick the box to "allow text messages from the organizer."

### 8. VENUE / COURSE

- 8.1 The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, west of the Marina del Rey Breakwater.
- 8.2 Course will use both MDR Marks, described in <u>Course Chart 17</u>, and orange or yellow inflatable marks.
- 8.3 The course will be approximately 13 miles. The rated distance will be set by the Race Committee.

#### 9. SERIES SCORING

Boats will be scored in the order of finish.

### 10. TROPHIES

- 10.1 Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC after the race for each class.
- 10.2 The Outlook High-Point Trophy will be awarded to the top finishing Keel Boat
- 10.3 The Outlook Perpetual Trophy is awarded to the first center board boat and to the first multihull provided that three or more boats are starting in each class.

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
