Rendezvous: At 1100 at Region 1 Mark B (RGR 3 Piling Mark) at Turkey Point.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Region 1 Mark "B" (RGR). If code flag "L" is

displayed, the starting line may be moved to between orange flag on Race Committee boat and

another navigation aid or a temporary drop mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races). Class starts may be added/combined/split based on entries.

Course: Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat. Special race buoy

drop-marks or government marks based on Region 1 Standard Racing Marks.

Finish: Between blue flag on Race Committee boat and last posted mark, unless course is shortened

after the start at a designated mark of the course.

Time Limit: 4 hour maximum time limit from the starting time for each class shall be imposed for all boats in a

class. At the discretion of the Race Committee this time limit may be adjusted, depending on time

constraints resulting from any postponements. This changes RRS 35.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024

(RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply." All changes to this NOR will be posted on the NERYC website prior to Saturday 05 June 2021.

Protests: Written protests must be submitted to the Race Committee via email within 3 hours of returning

to the NERYC dock or home port. Verbal notice of protest delivered to RC boat at finish.

Awards: Awards will be for 1st place for classes with 3 boats registered, 1st and 2nd place for classes with

5 boats registered, and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for classes with 7+ boats

A post-race dinner and party will be held and details will be announced prior to the regatta.
