

Ready About Sailing Inc. invites the Inland 20 scow class to our Demo Regatta at Chautauqua Lake, NY.

Notice of Race

July 8 – 9, 2023 sailing out of Long Point State Park, 4459 NY-Rt 430, Bemus Point, NY 14712

Sailing will consist of two days racing. On Saturday July 8, races 1,2,3 will be held at Chautauqua Yacht Club (CYC) on the northern end of the lake. On Sunday, July 9, races 4 and 5 will be held at Chautauqua Lake Yacht Club (CLYC) on the southern end of the lake. Boats will launch from Long Point State Park and be towed by on each day to the respective race venues.

Instructions

The Regatta is open to all Inland 20 Scows that meet the NISSA specifications. All safety equipment, as required by the class rules, shall be on board while racing. Anchor and line are not required to be carried.

Race Format (All times are Eastern Daylight Savings)

One race will constitute the regatta. There will be up to 6 races sailed, but the Race Committee may run fewer races at its discretion. On the final day of the regatta, the final race will not be started after 2:00 pm. Racing will be windward-leeward courses with the option of a downwind finish.

Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply. If 6 or more races are completed there will be a throw out.

Schedule of Events (All times are Eastern)

Optional on-site registration and check in will be at Long Point State Park Friday, 4pm – 7:30PM or Saturday morning from 7am to 9:30am.

Launching will take place at Long Point State Park both days and tow boats will take the fleet to each location. We would like to launch on Saturday morning at 10:00 am. Sunday launch time at 9:30am

Racing will start at 1pm on Saturday according to the traditional club racing schedule for CYC. We will run 3 races on Saturday.

Sunday racing will start at 11am and will consist of 2 races.

Please note that this event was put together to showcase the Inland 20 Scow to both CYC and CLYC in the hopes that we can anchor a fleet at one or both clubs. Currently there are two Inland20 scows at CYC. Ready About Sailing appreciates the overwhelming support we have received from the Class and its officers.

If participant is already a member of NISSA, the entry fee is \$75.

Registration before June 15, 6pm Eastern avoids a \$15 late fee.
