

2023 Classic Boat Regatta

Notice of Race

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in THE RACING RULES OF SAILING. Also, confirmation by the boat owner/representative that they will comply with the RRS and all other rules that govern this event. The navigation rules of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions (IRPCAS), replaces Part 2 of the previous versions of the RRS.

Appendix V, Rule V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) shall apply.

The intended racing area will be Knox Shoal (to the west of Angel Island). Courses will be windward/leeward using inflatable dropped marks.

The First Warning will be at 1100 hrs on all dates.

Entry is open to the following fleets of the CBRA of San Francisco Bay: Knarr, Folkboat, SFBIOD, Bear, and Bird. For the Knarr Class, SFBKA Articles Of Association will be in effect.

It is intended to run three races each day for the Knarr, Folkboat, and SFBIOD classes, two races for the Bird and Bear classes.

Scoring. One race will constitute a series. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores; this changes RRS A2.

Online entry is at the event website www.regattanetwork.com/event/26519. A mail-in entry form can be requested at race@sausalitoyachtclub.org, or picked up at SYC. The entry fee for the series is \$300 for Bear, Bird, Folkboat, and SFBIOD classes; \$400 for the Knarr class. For Bears/Birds/Folkboat and SFBIOD classes only, August 27th is an optional day of racing for which an additional fee of \$80 is payable.

Sailing Instructions will be posted at the event website as well as the club notice board by 1800 Thursday, June 8th. Results will be posted at the club notice board and on the event website after racing each day.
