

# 2023 Moore 24 National Championship

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the **rules** as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing**.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 applies.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Moore 24 boats that are current members of the Moore 24 Class Association may enter.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it with the required fee via the RN event URL :  
<https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26522>.
- 2.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 2.4 The registration deadline is 1800 hours, Tuesday, June 27, 2023.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$200/boat. (includes 4 dinner tickets)
- 3.2 Entries received after the deadline shall be subject to a \$40 additional late fee.
- 3.3 The late can be waived at the discretion of the Class Governing Board.
- 3.4 Registration closes at 1000 hours on Friday, June 30, 2023.

### 4. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 4.1 Boats may be inspected at any time for compliance with Moore 24 Class Rules.
- 4.2 Crew Weight Limit. Moore 24 Class Rule XIV requires crew weigh in, which must be completed prior to the close of registration, 3.4 above.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & VHF RADIOS

- 6.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on Regatta Network and the SCYC website.
- 6.2. All competitors are strongly encouraged to carry a VHF radio as the Race Committee will make courtesy announcements of impending starts.

## 8. THE COURSES

- 8.1 Marks and courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

## 9. SCORING

- 9.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3. When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat may exclude her worst score.
- 9.4 Rule A5.3 applies.

## 10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1 Boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## 11. INSURANCE

- 11.1 Participating boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per incident or the equivalent.

## 12. BERTHING

- 12.1 A launch ramp is available.
- 12.2 Courtesy berthing is not available. Trespassers may be cited. See <http://fresnoyachtclub.org/high-sierra-regatta/> for slip and mooring options.
- 12.3. Overnight dry storage is available in the parking area. Please obey parking control. No trailers may be parked in the beach area.

## 13. PRIZES

13.1 Awards will be presented for the top 5 entries

13.2 Additional special awards will be presented at the discretion of the organizers
