# **2023 Solstice Race**

June 17, 2023 through June 18, 2023

#### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

#### 2. Entries

Competitors may enter by completing the entry form through Regatta Network. This can be accessed by logging on to ccyc.org Sail Fleet, Racing Information, register. CCYC members \$20.00. Non-CCYC members \$30.00. Need to register before 0900 on the day of the race.

### 3. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the CCYC club house. "On the Sail Fleet bulletin Board". Or at ccyc.org Sail Fleet, Racing Information,

## 4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagstaff located at the east corner of the patio. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 10 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

# 5. Schedule and Class Flags.

The warning signal will be at 1055 on the day of the race.

Class 1 Less than 119 Code flag 1 Class 2 120 to 159 Code flag 2 Class 3 106 and above Code flag 3

- 1. Each boat is encouraged to race in the class specified by their rating.
- 2. It is up to each skipper to provide PHRF rating, or equivalent.
- 3. Spinnakers are allowed in all classes so they can sail to the full extent of their rating.
- 4. A boat not using a spinnaker in the race needs to request a

Non-Spinnaker rating from the Sail Fleet Captain CCYC.

- 5. Each boat can request to be moved to another class regardless of their rating.
- 6. The organizing authority reserves the right to move any boat to another class.

#### 6. Racing Area

The racing area will be San Diego Bay and off the harbor entrance.

#### 7. Course and Marks:

The Solstice Race start line will be adjacent to the Coronado Cays channel entrance and proceed outside the San Diego Bay entrance. After the start all racers will leave channel marker Red 26 to Port. At the harbor entrance all racers will leave channel marker Red 8 to Port then proceed to TG-1 Navy PA at 32deg 38.969N 117deg 10.740W. Leave TG-1 to starboard. Proceed to SD1 leave to starboard. Proceed to channel marker R26. Leave R26 to starboard. The Finish Line is between the Coronado Cay channel markers G1 and R2. Racers finishing will be required to record their own finish time and report it to the race committee.

# 8. Starting and Finishing Lines:

The Solstice Race start line will be adjacent to the Coronado Cays channel entrance. The Finish Line is between the Coronado Cay channel markers G1 and R2. Racers finishing will be required to record their own finish time and report it to the race committee. [The Sound Signal Starting System in Appendix S of the racing rules will be used.]

#### 9. Time Limit

All boats finishing after 0900 on June 18 2023 will be scored DNF.

## 10. Propulsion Rule 42.3i:

If aground. Permit propulsion using an engine or any other method, provided the boat does not gain a significant advantage in the race.

## 11. Protests

Protests shall be delivered to Race Committee ashore. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing.

## 12. Scoring

According to Appendix A of the racing rules of sailing.
