Management and Rules

The race will be sailed under the management of the PBYC Race Committee and will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the 2021 Pensacola Bay Sailing Instructions https://www.pensacolayachtclub.org/getmedia/82f0f4a8-b4ca-46fa-9139-0a402dc28f12/P_Bay_Gen_SI_s_wRRS2021-2024_Changes_1.aspx, except as modified by this Notice of Race (NOR), and or the Sailing Instructions (S I's) for this Regatta.

RACE FOR THE ROSES ELIGIBILITY: Open to all boats with a valid GYA PHRF rating; We will be implementing a minimum of 3 boats per class and minimum of 6 boats policy. If this is not met then we will reschedule the race for a later date. All boats must be helmed by female. we will sail with two groups. First must be 100% crewed by persons identifying as female in accordance with US Sailing's Gender Identification Interim Policy. Second group can be up to 50% female and 50% male.
