NOTICE OF RACE

King Kamehameha Offshore McFaul Beach Fleet July 29, 2023

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Rule 52 Is modified to allow the use of autopilot for doubled and single-handed racers only
 - 1.2.3. Rule 55 is changed to allow the use of banding for safety purposes
 - 1.2.4. Rule 63.2 and 63.4 do not apply.
- 2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the classes: X, A, B, Cal 20, Multi, and Cruising with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs or who have competed in Transpac 2023.
- 3.2. Yachts will be scored in a class if there are 3 or more entries
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting:

- **4. FEES:** The entry fees will be \$40.00 for local skiers and \$0 for Transpac skippers.
- 5. SCHEDULE
 - **5.1.** Regatta Network registration closes at the time of the skippers meeting
 - **5.2.** Skippers' Meeting: 1030 July 29, 2023
 - 5.3. First Warning: 1225 July 29, 2023
 - **5.4.** Number of Races: All fleets will have one distance race.
- 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network
- 7. VENUE: The Course Area will off the south shore of Oahu
- 8. COURCES: Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions
- **9. SCORING:** The scoring system is as follows:
 - 9.1. X, A, B, and Cruising will use PHRF Handicap rating systems as endorsed by HYRA
 - 9.2. Multi and Cal 20s will use The Low Point Scoring System
- 10. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony
