1. RULES

1.1. The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, including US Sailing Prescriptions and Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Advertising shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4. The regatta is open to all yachts that are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authorities.
5. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing Regatta Network website.

6. MOORING

6.1. Mooring in Lahaina prior to the regatta is available on a first-come, first serve basis. The Lahaina Small Boat Harbor typically has moorings and a limited number of slips available. The Harbor Agents can be reached at 808-662-4060. LYC has several moorings available for visiting yachts. The LYC office can be reached at 808-661-0191. Anchoring is available between the mooring field and shore.

6.2. Mooring in Waikiki after the regatta is available on a first come first serve basis. Temporary moorings may be available at the Ala Wai Harbor or at the HYC Aloha Dock. The Ala Wai Harbor Master can be reached at 808-973-9727. Contact Travis Scott (808) 383-3619 for moorage at Hawaii Yacht Club.

9. MEASUREMENTS

9.1. Each boat in PHRF class shall have a valid YRA / NCPHRF Northern California Performance Handicap Racing Fleet handicap certificate. The NCPHRF certificate application can be found at WWW.YRA.org.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

10.1. Sailing instructions will be available at the skippers meeting and on Regatta Network.

11. SCORING

11.1. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.

11.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

12. PRIZES

12.1. For each class a first prize will be awarded if at least three boats enter, second prize will be awarded if at least five boats enter, and third prize will be awarded if at least seven boats enter.
