NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 Rules will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions (SIs).

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is N/A for this regatta.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all members of Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations recognized by US Sailing.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network [[CYC RACING](#)]
- 3.3 All entries must be submitted by **the day before the race at 5:00pm.**
- 3.4 No late entries will be accepted.

4 CLASSIFICATION

- 4.1 There will be at least three classes. The first two classes use SD PHRF RLC for scoring with class 3 being the non-spinnaker class using CYC handicaps. Spinnaker offsets are accepted for classes 1 and 2. Register with rating appropriate to your intended use of spinnaker.
- 4.2 There will be a rating credit for all-female crew. Race committee will adjust ratings and corresponding start times. Note if you will have an all-female or coed crew in your registration. A male boat owner may ride on a boat with an all-female crew as a non-participating safety observer.
- 4.3 If there are enough registrants in both the all-female and co-ed categories, classes will be subdivided for scoring.

One	SD PHRF RLC 113 and Below
Two	SD PHRF RLC 114 and Above
Three	CYC Handicap

5 FEES

- 5.1 Fee for non-Coronado Yacht Club (CYC) participants is \$30.
- 5.2 Prizes will be noted in the SIs and will be presented after completion of the race.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be posted on Regatta Network by 5:00pm the day before the race.
- 6.2 The start times will be available at the CYC Office by **10:00 am race day**.

7 VENUE and DATES

- 7.1 This is a one-day race on August 20, 2023. One race will be held.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 Course(s) will be outlined in the SIs. All courses will start and finish in the vicinity of Coronado Yacht Club. The courses will be located primarily in the South Bay but may include a mark north of the Coronado Bay Bridge.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. The SIs will discuss the radio channel for emergency communication.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be presented after completion of the race.
- 10.2 Prizes will include awards for spirit.

11 POST-RACE SOCIAL

- 11.1 Light lunch and beverages will be provided at CYC after the race.

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
