NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in:

- 1.1.1.** The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.1.2.** The current PHRF regulations, as administered by YRA of Long Island Sound (YRALIS).
- 1.1.3.** US SAFETY EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS (SER), Nearshore Category.
- 1.1.4.** RRS Appendix V Sections 1 and 2.
- 1.1.5.** RUNNING LIGHTS MUST BE DISPLAYED FROM THE FIRST WARNING SIGNAL.

1.2. The following racing rules will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

- 1.2.1.** RRS 44.1 "Penalty at the Time of an Incident" is modified as specified in RRS V1.
- 1.2.2.** RRS 62.1(a) is amended to add "Failure of a boat to see or hear her recall notification and the timing and order of such hail shall not be cause for redress."
- 1.2.3.** RRS 61.1(a) is amended to include "A boat initiating a protest shall immediately after finishing, notify the race committee over VHF channel 72 of its intent to lodge a protest and the identity of the boat(s) being protested, then repeating the notification at [reasonable] intervals until acknowledged by the race committee."
- 1.2.4.** RRS 61.3 and 62.2 are changed such that the time limit for protests is 2200 hours on the day following the race.
- 1.2.5.** RRS 35, A4, and A5 are modified to include a finishing time limit window.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1.** The regatta is open to boats who competed in the Lloyd Harbor Yacht Club Summer Series. Boats will be registered automatically in their appropriate fleets.
- 2.2.** This is a non-spinnaker race. For boats that sailed with spinnakers in the Summer Series, the N-Spin W/L rating on your current certification will be used.
- 2.3.** Whisker poles are limited to the J length or length as indicated on the PHRF Certificate.

3. FEES

- 3.1.** There is no fee for this event.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1.** Racing is scheduled Wednesday, July 26, 2023.
- 4.2.** The scheduled time for the first warning signal is 1900 hours.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing instructions will be available on the club web site by July 12 at 1800 hours.
- 5.2. Scratch Sheets will be available on the club web site by 1800 hours on the day prior to the event. The Regatta Network "Current Registrants" list is NOT the Scratch Sheet.

6. VENUE

- 6.1. The venue is Huntington Bay. The starting area will be made in Huntington Bay but no further north than Nun "6" off Lloyd Neck.

7. COURSES

- 7.1. The course for all classes will be indicated by the race committee and be windward/leeward using drop marks and Bell "8" (Target Rock) as appropriate. Each leg will be approximately one mile.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1. RRS 44 is modified as specified in RRS Appendix V1 and V2.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. Time allowances will be per YRALIS PHRF procedures using the Time-on-Time method.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1. Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 72.
- 10.2. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to all mobile devices.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows for each class: First if there are three or more competitors, Second, if five or more, and Third, if seven or more.
- 11.2. The Champion of Champions title will be awarded to the winner of the Clash of the Champions division.
- 11.3. The Champion of Contenders title will be awarded to the winner of the Clash of the Contenders division.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

- 13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
