



NOTICE OF RACE

Published: September 1, 2023

Abbreviations: OA - Organizing Authority | RC - Race Committee | RRS - Racing Rules of Sailing | NOR - Notice of Race | SIs - Sailing Instructions | ONB - Official Notice Board

All hours are expressed in Eastern Standard Time (EST).

1. RULES

- a. The OA and Host of the Regatta is the Coconut Grove Sailing Club.
- b. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- c. Class rules regarding qualifying events and championships will not apply.

2. ADVERTISING

a. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- a. The Regatta is open to the following classes and divisions that meet the obligations of their Class Rules and their National Authority, including current membership.
 - i. Optimist Championship (Red, White, and Blue) Fleet -- The Red, Blue and White Fleet assignments will be based on the competitor's age on the first scheduled day of racing, October 28, 2023.
 - ii. Optimist Green Fleet -- The Green Fleet is intended for less experienced sailors and will include opportunities for learning and competition.
 - 1. Competitors in the Opti Classes shall have been born on or after January 1, 2008.
 - 2. After 100 RWB or Green fleet sailors have registered, later registrants may be waitlisted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
 - iii. Youth Laser -- All ILCA 4 and ILCA 6 rigs are welcome. Sailors are free to choose their rig size at registration, depending on their fitness level, height, age and weight but shall not change their selected rig size after registration.
 - 1. Competitors in the Laser classes shall have been born on or after January 1, 2004.
 - iv. v. Club 420 -- The Club 420 class is invited for the 2023 event.
 - 1. Competitors in the C420 class shall have been born on or after January 1, 2003.
 - 2. Parental consent forms will be required for competitors under age 20 as of December 31, 2022.
- b. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration through Regatta Network: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26891#_registration</u>
- c. Entry fees are determined by payment date and time, not by registration time.
- d. To be accepted, each registration must have completed online waivers and medical forms.
- d. Entries will be accepted online until Oct. 25, 2023.
- fi. No entries will be accepted on regatta days.

4. COMPETITORS' REGISTRATION FEES & REFUND POLICY

a. Fees to all classes, include all taxes, and are determined by payment date and time.

b. 100% refund (less \$15 processing fee) if the regatta is canceled due to State, County, or City guidelines.

- (ii) Refunds will be processed by submitted date as follows:
 75% refund if written request received by Sep. 30, 2023
 50% refund if written request received between Oct.01 Oct. 20, 2023
 No refunds will be issued after Oct. 20, 2023 I'm
 A refund charge of \$15⁰⁰ will be applied to cover the administrative expenses.
- (iii) There will be no new registrations accepted after October 25, 2023.

5. SPECTATOR, SUPPORT & COACH VESSELS

- All coach and support (parent & spectator) vessels must register online (without fee) at the following Regatta Network website (which is different from the competitor's site): <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25150</u>
- b. This is a mandatory (and free process) to ensure that the OA has adequate contact information.
- c. Each coach and support (parent & spectator) vessel must check-in at the Regatta Desk and receive a coach or support vessel ID flag (\$50 cash deposit)
- d. There is no berthing available at CGSC for non-CGSC coach and support vessels.
- e. Each support vessel shall have a working VHF radio, an anchor suitable for anchoring in the waiting area and a basic first aid kit.
- f. [DP] All support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the operator at all times while the engine is running.

8. BERTHING

- a. Boats will be launched, hauled and stored at CGSC, with the exception of Coral Reef Yacht Club and Key Biscayne Yacht Club. Boats from CRYC and KBYC will be launched, hauled and stored at the competitor's respective home club.
- b. Each boat on CGSC premises shall have a marked dolly with name and fleet.
- c. All CGSC boats shall be kept in their assigned area until their respective harbor launch times.
- d. <u>All skippers and crews must properly dispose of trash while ashore.</u> Trash left on the ground will not be tolerated.
- e. While ashore, all skippers and crews are to promptly comply with instructions from the CGSC Staff.

9. VENUE

a. The regatta will be on Biscayne Bay hosted by the Coconut Grove Sailing Club.

10. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be listed in the Sailing Instructions (SI).
