1 RULES

- 1.1 This Regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Class Rules of each fleet, including current Class Membership (if applicable).
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 shall apply while crew are on the water.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be available after 1500 hrs. on Wednesday, October 11, 2023 at the Richmond Yacht Club and on the Richmond Yacht Club website.
- 2.2 Changes to the *rules* will be posted on the official notice board by 0930 on the day they will take effect. Changes to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 on the day before they will take effect.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26897
- 3.2 The VHF channel used by the RC will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The following One Design classes have been invited: Olson 25, Wabbit, J/24. Skippers must be members in good standing with their class and must conform with any class rules required by their fleet.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at:
 - Ihttps://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26897
- 4.3 No entries will be accepted after 1800 hrs. on Wednesday, October 11, 2023..

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for Olson and Wabbit fleets for 3 days of racing is \$100. (Friday: Distance Saturday/Sunday: Buoy racing)
- 5.2 The entry fee for J/24 for 2 days of racing is \$80.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The Olson 25 and Wabbits will have a distance race on Friday, October 13. First warning 1355.
- 6.2 Buoy racing on Saturday and Sunday. First warning at 1125.
- 6.3 Seven (7) buoy races are scheduled. No more than four (4) races per day.
- 6.4 There will be no start after 15:30 on Sunday.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The racing area on Friday will be a distance race using fixed marks for Olsons and Wabbits and will be described further in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2 The racing area Saturday will be in the vicinity of Southampton and Brooks Island. Racing will be around temporary marks.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 Each boat's regatta score shall be the total of their race scores. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.
- 8.3 Friday's Distance Race:
 - Olson 25: This race will be included in the regatta score as indicated in NOR 8.2.
 - Wabbit: This race will be excluded from the regatta score. However, it will be used as the first tie-breaker if results are tied. This amends RRS A8(2).
- 8.4 Final scores will not be on Regatta Network. They will be posted on the Notice Board located outside the downstairs race room.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 First place will be awarded to the winner of the distance race on Friday for each class.
- 9.1 Class Prizes will be awarded by each fleet:
 - Olson 25 Nationals
 - Wabbit Nationals
 - J/24 District Championship
- 9.2 The trophy presentation will be held on the RYC deck after the racing on Sunday, October 15th.

10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
