Dear Competitor:

HOUSING AND BEHAVIOR:

Housing will be provided in local club members' homes. Every attempt will be made to house teams together but no guarantees will be made. Sailors may not make their own arrangements and local teams will be required to house visiting teams. Curfew each night is 10pm. No exceptions!! Anyone arriving after curfew or causing problems with his host family will be referred to the Regatta Chair and the Protest Committee for action.

A "zero tolerance" policy regarding the use of alcohol and/or any illegal drug by a competitor will be in effect during the event. Offenders will be reprimanded strictly as stated in the NOR. Attendance at all events is mandatory.

Housing will not be provided for coaches, parents or spectators. Sailors may not stay with their parents or coaches during the event. If parents are interested in coming, a list of local hotels can be made available.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

AIR

Book your flights to San Diego International/Lindberg Field (SAN) only!! Ground transportation will not be provided; it is a \$10-\$20 shuttle ride from the airport (depending on which yacht club). Most major airlines fly in/out of San Diego International and sailors going east should not have a problem booking a flight out Wednesday night after 2100hrs. No sailor should book a flight prior to 2100hrs on the final day to allow time for the Awards Ceremony and travel to the airport.

Sailors competing in the Triplehanded Championship will report directly to the Mission Bay Yacht Club from the airport.

Sailors competing in the Singlehanded or Doublehanded Championship will report directly to the San Diego Yacht Club from the airport.

The recommended ground transportation carrier is Cloud 9 Shuttle (Super Shuttle). You can book and prepay your shuttle from home. **Please do not book a round trip airport shuttle; we will coordinate the shuttles back to the airport based on the flights of all sailors.**

GROUND

If you will be driving to the event, you must check in at the San Diego Yacht Club on Sunday morning to surrender your car keys prior to completing registration. Competitors may not transport themselves or their crew during the course of the championship. Our committee has arranged to transport all of the competitors to/from each event.

If your parents will be transporting you, please have them drive you to the Mission Bay Yacht Club for Triplehanded Competitors or San Diego Yacht Club for everyone else (directions are available on the website) for registration. They may pick you up after 2100hrs on Wednesday night (additional tickets for the awards dinner will be available if they would like to attend).

UPDATING YOUR TRAVEL INFORMATION

When you registered for the championship, you received a link in your confirmation from Regatta Network to input your travel information. You can use that link to go into your registration and update it at any time up until August 2, 2010. REGISTRATION

Registration is scheduled for Sunday August 15, 2010, from 0930-1300. Competitors will be issued their charter boats and receive their entry packets and meal tickets during this time. No one may go on to the water without going through registration first.

Registration for the Triplehanded Championship will be at the Mission Bay Yacht Club; please report directly to MBYC.

Registration for the Singlehanded and Doublehanded Championship will be at the San Diego Yacht Club; please report directly to SDYC. Singlehanded competitors will be ferried to SWYC after completing registration.

DRESS CODE

Sailors must wear appropriate shoes at all times in the boat, parks and buildings. While inside clubhouses shirts, dry shorts and shoes will be required (this is California, we consider sandals/flip flops to be shoes). The dress code for the awards banquet will be yacht club casual (collared shirt, Hawaiian shirt, khaki shorts, etc. and the equivalent for girls, please no ties or jackets).



MEALS

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided for all competitors starting with lunch on Sunday August 15 and ending with dinner on Wednesday August 18. Additional dinner tickets will be available for purchase online at the regatta website or during registration. Spectator lunches may be ordered from the regatta website.

MEDICAL CONCERNS

There will be a credentialed nurse or medic on the premises/water each day of the competition. If you have specific medical questions or concerns please contact the regatta chair.

BOATS

All boats will be provided for competitors at the finals. Sailors in the Singlehanded and Doublehanded Championship will have to clear all documents with the onsite LaserPerformance Representative prior to picking up a boat and Triplehanded Competitors will clear all documents with MBYC CHARTER REP.

SPECTATOR BOATS

Spectator boats may be provided for the Singlehanded/Doublehanded Race Course if there are five or more requests for each day. Racing for the Triplehanded Fleet will be immediately in front of Mission Bay Yacht Club so viewing from the front deck will be more than adequate (a pair of binoculars will let you see what brand of sunglasses the skipper is wearing).

PERSONAL GEAR

San Diego in mid August will be warm but the water is still in the low to mid 60's. Sailors should plan to wear a long-sleeved technical shirt, boardshorts and spray top and possibly a short-sleeved wetsuit if you normally get cold. Hat and sunglasses are necessary as also a good sunscreen. It will be significantly warmer on land than it will be on the race course so bring layers and a light jacket or fleece for after racing, as it cools off quickly when the sun sets.

420 Charter Terms/ US SAILING Events 10

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No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, sail, hull and fittings shall be made except for those permitted by class rules.

1. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
2. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited. Competitors may wash their boat with detergent and water.
3. Substitutions of rigging, blocks and any other equipment is governed by class rules and the NORs
4. No fitting may be removed, even if it is subsequently replaced, and no repairs may be undertaken without the permission of the Organizing Committee. Note: All the fittings are sealed with silicon during manufacture.
5. The use of the charter boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the LaserPerformance Representative and the Organizing Committee, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of charter or treats or handles a charter boat without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.
6. No drilling or piercing of any part of the boat or equipment is permitted.
7. Tape residue, scuffs or any marks that can be removed without sanding or repair must be so removed at the end of the event by the competitor. The use of duct tape is prohibited.
8. All equipment (including hull/sails/spars) should be rinsed free of salt, sand or dirt incurred from the site. It is the responsibility of the competitor to return the equipment in an appropriate state.
9. Any competitor found towing at more than 5kts will be charged \$500 and have the equipment withdrawn immediately
10. The host club will ONLY charge a sailor's card if that sailor is to be charged for damage
11. If the host club will incur an extra charge for running a sailor's card, that charge will be added to the amount the sailor owes for damages. (usually 2-3% of charge).

I agree that in addition to the charter fee and damage deposit, my credit card may be charged during the event up to \$400.00 per incident.

All the masts have been checked to make sure they are within the design tolerance. Competitors are reminded that masts may be more likely to bend if high boom vang loadings are used.

1. No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, sail, hull and fittings shall be made except as follows:
2. A compass, wind indicator and sail tell tales supplied by the competitor may be used provided that they can be fitted without piercing or otherwise marking the hull, spars or sail.
3. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
4. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited. Competitors may wash their boat with detergent and water.
5. Plastic tape or similar may be used in accordance with the Class Rules.
6. No fitting may be removed, even if it is subsequently replaced, and no repairs may be undertaken without the written permission of the LaserPerformance Representative and the Organizing Committee. Note: All the fittings are sealed with silicon during manufacture.
7. The use of the charter boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the LaserPerformance Representative and Organizing Committee, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of charter or treats or handles a charter boat without due care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.
8. Boats will be supplied with all equipment used. No alterations will be allowed.
9. Any competitor found towing at more than 5kts will be charged \$500 and have the equipment withdrawn immediately

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No changes, additions, or alterations to the spars, sail, hull and fittings shall be made except for those permitted by class rules.

1. Wet or dry sanding of the hulls or any other equipment is prohibited.
2. The use of waxes, polishing compounds or similar is prohibited. Competitors may wash their boat with detergent and water.
3. Substitutions of rigging, blocks and any other equipment is governed by class rules and the NORs
4. No fitting may be removed, even if it is subsequently replaced, and no repairs may made or undertaken without the permission of the Organizing Committee.
5. The use of the charter boat may be withdrawn if, in the sole opinion of the Mission Bay Yacht Club Representative and the Organizing Committee, a competitor breaks any of the conditions of charter or treats or handles a charter boat without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat.
6. No drilling or piercing of any part of the boat or equipment is permitted.
7. Tape residue, scuffs or any marks that can be removed without sanding or repair must be so removed at the end of the event by the competitor. The use of duct tape is prohibited.
8. All equipment (including hull/sails/spars) should be rinsed free of salt, sand or dirt incurred from the site. It is the responsibility of the competitor to return the equipment in an appropriate state.
9. Any competitor found towing at more than 5kts will be charged \$500 and have the equipment withdrawn immediately
10. The host club will ONLY charge a sailor's card if that sailor is to be charged for damage
11. If the host club will incur an extra charge for running a sailor's card, that charge will be added to the amount the sailor owes for damages. (usually 2-3% of charge).
12. The competitors are expected to leave their boats in the same if not better condition than they found them.
