1. RULES

1.1. The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, including US Sailing Prescriptions and Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Advertising shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4. The regatta is open to all yachts that are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authorities.
5. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing Regatta Network website.

6. MOORING

- 6.1. Town-side mooring will be provided by HYC and WYC free of charge. Contact John Climaldi ASAP for reservations at JohnClimaldi@hawaiilife.com.
- 6.2. Kaneohe side mooring will be provided by KYC free of charge. Contact Travis Scott ASAP for reservations.

7.1. Required fees are as follows:

9. MEASUREMENTS

9.1. Each boat in PHRF class shall have a NCPHRF rating. If a boat does not have a valid rating certification, race committee can provide a rating.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

10.1. Sailing instructions will be available at the skippers meeting and on Regatta Network.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.
- 11.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.



12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or the continue racing is hers alone. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

- 13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$500,000 per event or the equivalent.
