## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1. Rules**

The Organizing Authority is the Eau Gallie Yacht Club in conjunction with J-24 Fleet 87. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### **2. Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA that possess a valid measurement certificate. Competitors must meet all ownership and class membership requirements and complete all aspects of the registration process.

### **3. Entry and Fees**

Entry must be made on-line through Regatta Networks by 1000 Saturday, September 30, 2023.

Regatta Entry Fee: \$195.00

Registration fee includes all racing, launch/haul and specified social activities.

Boat Launching, hauling is at Eau Gallie Yacht Club.

NOTE: Boat Launching at EGYC is only Saturday, September 30, 2023 from 0800 to 1100.

Boat hauling is only Sunday, October 1, 2023 from 1330 to 1730.

### **4. Schedule of Events**

Following Racing awards will be presented at the EGYC.

## **5. Inspection**

All boats may be subject to random inspection or measurement by the Technical Committee at any time during the Regatta for Rules Compliance and may be required to show compliance with Part D Class Measurement and Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment forms. All participants may be subject to verification of declared crew weight per Class Rules.

## **6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions will be available at check in prior to the Competitors meeting and may be available on Regatta Network. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 15 minutes after the Competitors' Meeting to be effective on Saturday, September 30, 2023, or 0800 on Sunday, October 1, 2023 to be effective on that date. On-the-water changes may be made to the Sailing Instructions in accordance with Rule 89.2[c] after Flag L is displayed with one sound.

## **7. Regatta Venue**

Moorage will be available at the Eau Gallie Yacht Club but not required.

## **8. Racing Area**

The racing area will be North of the Eau Gallie Causeway on the Indian River.

## **9. Courses**

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. Scoring**

The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A will be modified such that a boat's worst score will be excluded after completion of six races. Seven (7) races are scheduled of which one (1) completed race shall constitute a Regatta. This modifies Rule A2.

## **11. Penalties**

RRS Penalty Rules 44.1 as modified by the Sailing Instructions (Appendix V) shall apply when a boat may have broken one or more Rules in Part 2 or Rule 31.

## **12. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the top three places.
