SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#), [the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#), the NOR, and these Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall take precedence.

- 2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:**
 - 2.1 Official notices will be posted on the official noticeboard located on the second floor in the bar area.
 - 2.2 Changes to the sailing instructions shall be approved by the PRO and shall be posted on the official notice board, with an announcement prior to taking effect.

- 3. SCHEDULE:**
 - 3.1 Report times each day are listed in the NOR.
 - 3.2 The number of races each day will be at the discretion of the regatta chair.

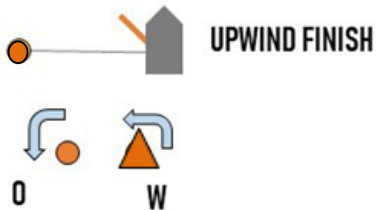
- 4. COURSES AND MARKS:**
 - 4.1 The courses will be announced before each race and will be taken from the Course Diagram on the Notice Board.
 - 4.2 All marks will be orange tetrahedrons, except the starting mark (pin), finishing mark, and offset mark, which will be orange balls.

- 5. START/FINISH AND SIGNALS:**
 - 5.1 Races will start in accordance with ISSA PR 7.9(a).
 - 5.2 The starting line will be between an orange staff on the signal boat and an orange ball. The finish line will be between a blue staff on the starboard side of the signal boat and an orange ball. This changes RRS Race Signals.
 - 5.3 The ILCA 7 fleet class flag is a white flag. The ILCA 6 girls' fleet class flag is a yellow flag. The ILCA 6 boys' class flag is a light blue flag.

- 6. FORMAT:**
 - 6.1 The committee will attempt to complete 12 races. One race will constitute a regatta. Preference is to complete 7 races on Saturday, and 5 on Sunday.

7. **PROTESTS:** Protests shall be filed within 30 minutes of the last boat reaching shore at the end of the day or any other breaks in racing taken ashore. Changes ISSA PR 16d. Protest forms will be available in the BWYC Office on the Second Floor and handed to a protest committee official.
- 7.1 Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be presented by the competitors as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6.
8. **SCORING:** Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.
9. **COACHING:**
- 9.1 Limited Coach boats will be available.
- 9.2 Limited spectator boats will be available.
- 9.3 Per ISSA PR 8(b), any sailor who intends to protest MUST report to the race committee BEFORE talking with any support personnel in coach boats. Failure to do this may be grounds for closing the protest hearing. This changes RRS 61.
10. **SAFETY:** A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee either before leaving the course, or if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore.
