Amended NOTICE OF RACE

WYC/HYC Beach Fleet Championships

1. RULES:
 - 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
 - 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
 - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
 - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.
3. CLASSES: Boats will be scored in A, B, Cruising, and Cal 20 Fleets
4. FEES: The entry fees will be \$30.00 for each yacht. No fee for Cal 20's

Outbound: Port rounding of Diamond Head Buoy and committee boat in Maunalua Bay.
Inbound: Starboard rounding of Diamond Head Buoy and a race to the finish!

Cal 20 DH Buoy and back, port rounding of DH Buoy.

COURSES: Detailed course information will be in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING: RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

8. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented for racing class and cruising class at the awards ceremony
