WYC Beach Fleet Championships and Beer Can Bash September 23rd, 2023

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

RULES:

- 1. 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
 - 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.

1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.

1.2.4.Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the WYC on the regatta board.

- 2. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 09:00 on the day it will take effect
- **3.** SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: Signals made ashore will be displayed from the WYC flagpole.
- **4.** SCHEDULE: Entry deadline Skippers' Meeting September 23rd 0900

5. SCHEDULE OF RACING:

- 5.1. AMENDED: The first warning for Cal 20 and Cruiser/Multi class will be at 1100 Saturday September 23rd, 2023. The first warning for A-B fleet will be at 1110 Saturday September 23rd, 2023
- 5.2. Number of races: 1

6. CLASS FLAGS:

6.1. Class A and B – Pink with X6.2. Cal 20 - Black C20 Flag6.3 Cruiser and Multi - Blue Multi Flag

- 7. **START:** The starting line for all classes will be between two inflatable tetrahedrons outside the Ala Wai harbor entrance west/Ewa side. Boats should pass the starting line on starboard tack.
- 8. FINISH: The finish line will be the same location as the start line.
- **9. MARKS:** Diamond Head Buoy, Committee Boat anchored outside Maunalua Bay. Committee boat will be flying a White RC Commodore flag (white with red anchor and stars), a WYC Burgee and Kansas City Chiefs flag. You can't miss it! The way-points and exact location coordinates of the Committee Boat will be given at the skippers meeting.
- COURSE: A&B Open ocean race starting off Waikiki, Ala Wai Harbor entrance (west side) and heading east to Maunalua Bay. Outbound: Port rounding of Diamond Head Buoy and committee boat in Maunalua Bay. Inbound: Starboard rounding of Diamond Head Buoy and a race to the finish. COURSE CAL 20, Cruiser, Multi: Open ocean race starting off Waikiki, Ala Wai Harbor entrance (west side) and heading to the Diamond Head Buoy, port rounding of the Diamond Head Buoy, then heading back to the start/ finish area.

11. RACING AREA: A/B Waikiki area heading east to Maunalua Bay and back to Waikiki.

CAL 20, Cruiser, Multi: Waikiki area heading to DH Buoy and back

- **12. PRIZES:** Prizes will be presented for Classes A and B, Cruiser, and Cal 20 at the awards ceremony
