1. RULES:

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
1.2.1. Puls 52 is changed to allow the use of percent winches.

1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches

1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.

1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.

1.2.4.Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.

- 2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.
- 1. CLASSES: Boats will be scored in A, B, Cruising, and Cal 20 Fleets
- 2. FEES: The entry fees will be \$30.00 for each yacht. No fee for Cal 20's 5.1. Entry fees are to be paid https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/25306
