### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS).

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is an invitational event and only members of one of the South Bay Yacht Clubs (Coronado YC, Coronado Cays YC, or Navy San Diego YC) that have qualified for the championship regatta are eligible (to qualify you must have completed one race in any of the three events hosted by each Yacht Club).**
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network.
- 2.3. Entries are limited to single-hulled boats 20 feet or more in length (LOA).
- 2.4. All entries must be submitted by 1700 the day prior to the regatta. No Late entries will be accepted.

#### 3. CLASSIFICATION

- 3.1. The following classes will be offered:
  - 3.1.1. Class 2 – Buoy Leg Rating of -9 through +50.
  - 3.1.2. Class 3 – Buoy Leg Rating of +51 through 89.
  - 3.1.3. Class 4 – Buoy Leg Rating of +90 through +137.
  - 3.1.4. Class 5 – Buoy Leg Rating of +138 through +999.
  - 3.1.5. Class 6 – Non-Spinnaker, Buoy Leg Rating of -999 through +177.
  - 3.1.6. Class 7 – Non-Spinnaker, Buoy Leg Rating of +178 through +999.
- 3.2. The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts, or in a prominent manner on the stern, when checking in, while racing, and when finishing. Competitors shall supply their own numeral pennant.

#### 4. FEES

4.1. Fees for each race are determined by the hosting regatta (no more than \$30).

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The sailing instructions will be posted on regatta network and available at the host Club by 1700 the day prior to the regatta.

6. VENUE and DATES

6.1. This course will be located in the South Bay.

6.2. The SBC regatta is 3 qualifying regattas hosted by each yacht club and a championship regatta hosted by the winner of record. In order to qualify for the championship regatta a boat must have completed a race in one of the qualifying regattas.

6.2.1. SBC Winter – Hosted by Coronado Yacht Club [February 5, 2022].

6.2.2. SBC Summer – Hosted by Navy Yacht Club [July 16, 2022].

6.2.3. SBC Fall – Hosted by the Coronado Cays Yacht Club [September 11, 2022].

**6.2.4. SBC Championship – Hosted by the Coronado Cays Yacht Club [October 8, 2022].**
