

## 2023/2024 Chili Midwinter Series

### NOTICE OF RACE

November 5<sup>th</sup> - December 3<sup>rd</sup> - January 7<sup>th</sup> - February 4<sup>th</sup> - March 3<sup>rd</sup>

The Sausalito Yacht Club invites Bay Sailors to come out for the SYC Chili Midwinter Series. Races are held on the first Sunday of the month from November through March. Racing will take place in the Knox / Yellow Bluff area using courses optimized for conditions.

1. Entry is open to all yachts with a current PHRF certificate or members of one-design fleets. Five or more one-design entries may constitute a class. Yachts without a PHRF Certificate may be assigned a rating at the discretion of the Race Committee.
2. Competitors may complete their entry online through the event website at the following link:

3. There will be divisions for Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and Double-Handed Non-Spinnaker.
4. Early entry helps the Race Committee create divisions that give the best competition. The entry fee for the series is \$180 for the entire series with a \$20 early registration discount if payment is made on or before October 29<sup>th</sup>. Individual races will be charged \$45.
5. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) shall govern this Series. The boat owner/representative must confirm that they will comply with the RRS and all other rules that govern this event. The navigation rules of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions (IRPCAS), replaces Part 2 of the previous versions of the RRS.
6. The completion of one race will constitute a series. If five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score; otherwise, her score will be the total of her scores for the series. RRS A5.3 applies.
7. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website and available at the club no later than 1800 Friday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
8. The first warning signal for each race will be sounded at 1200.
9. Results will be posted to the club's race notice board and the event website after each race.
10. Trophies will be awarded to winners of individual races after each race. Series trophies will be awarded to series entrants after the last race of the series; single race entries are not eligible for series trophies.
