- 1 Rules
- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as noted and changed by the sailing instructions or this Notice of Race.
- 1.2 USCG approved life jackets must be worn while on the water on all boats smaller than 21 feet LOA.
- 1.3 Shoes are to be worn at the Sailing Center at all times.
- 2 Eligibility and Entry
 - 2.1 Registration will be available on Regatta Network (https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27122)
- 2.2 Late registrations will be taken on-site the morning of the competition during check-in. Registrants will enter information on the Regatta Network web site on location or will complete the equivalent paperwork. Please pre-register for our event!
- 2.3 The race is open to all boats with a valid RYA Portsmouth rating. Ratings are taken from the RYA database using the Regatta Network system.
- 2.4 Any modifications a competitor makes to a boat that violates its class's rules, or initial design, must be declared on the registration application or at check in. Adjustment of the Portsmouth Rating will be applied at the discretion of the Race Committee and will be communicated with the registrant before the Skippers' Meeting as needed. The deadline to declare modifications is the closing of registration. Failure to declare modifications will result in a DSQ for the race.
- Fees: Save \$15! Please register online by 10/29 to receive the discount. Registration is valid on the date of payment. If you pay on the day of the race at check in, checks, cash or credit/debit cards are accepted. Boaters not registered by the early registration deadline must pay the full entry fee, which includes a \$15 late fee.

The starting sequence and course will be reviewed by diagram and chalk board at the Skippers' Meeting.

After racing, there will be a Thanksgiving meal and an awards presentation. All competitors and guests, please bring a side dish to share. A separate call for participation in food sharing will be made at the beginning of the week of the event.

5 Venue

Racing will be on and around the Intracoastal Waterway, locally known as the Halifax River, between Orange Avenue Memorial Bridge and the Dunlawton Bridge. Boats may be launched at the Bethune Point Park public ramp just north of HSA by trailer, or by dolly at HSA. Parking is limited to outside of the Sailing Center.

6 Course

The course for the distance race will be approximately 8-10 miles, depending on wind conditions. The specific details of the course will be covered during the skippers' meeting. Boats that do not follow the proper course will be scored NSC.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 The distance race will be comprised of only one race.
- 7.2 Each boat's finish time will be the corrected time in accordance with the RYA Portsmouth rating of that boat as listed on Regatta Network.
- 7.3 Boats not listed will have a value assigned at the discretion of the R/C. Modifications are adjusted as prescribed by US Sailing and should be reported no later than check-in for the race.
- 7.4 The R/C reserves the right to reclassify a boat in the spirit of improved competition based on registered competitors.

8 Awards

- 8.1 Awards will be given to the top boat in each class: centerboard dinghy, keelboat, and multihull.
- 8.2 A turkey, a chicken, and a Cornish game-hen will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall respectively.
- 8.3 The fastest boat scored on corrected time with an LOA >= 21ft will be awarded the Stargazer Trophy
- The fastest boat scored on corrected time with an LOA < 21ft will be awarded the Chris Baker Trophy

9 Disclaimer of Liability

All competitors will be required to sign a waiver of liability as a condition of entry. Parents/guardians must sign for competitors under 18.
