SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - JIB PACKING

1. RULES

1.1 This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, rules of the South Texas PHRF, the Notice of Regatta, and these Sailing Instructions. If said rules are contradicted in any way by these Sailing Instructions, then these Sailing Instructions are controlling.

2. ENTRIES

Any PHRF Yacht registered to compete in the Centennial Regatta is eligible to compete. Two (2) members of each PHRF competing yacht is required to participate to be awarded points.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any amendments to the Sailing Instructions will either be posted on Regatta Network and/or the CCYC Lanai.

3.2 The Race Committee (RC) reserves the right to also amend the Sailing Instructions orally if necessary.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 Close of registration will be 1700 hours on Thursday November 9, 2023 competition will began after a competitors meeting to review the rules and scoring.

4.2 Each Competitor will have until 1800 to complete two (2) attempts. Best attempt will be used. No practice attempts.

5. RULES AND SCORING

5.1 Official certified Regatta Sail, Tape and Timers shall be used.

5.2 Competitors will have 1 hour to complete two attempts. Competitors may complete each attempt concurrently or within the rotation. Overall time may be added to ensure all have an opportunity to complete their two attempts.

5.3 Competitors will lay out the sail flat on the ground.

5.4 Once ready time will start once the team touches the sail to begin folding.

5.5 Once tied using one (1) sail tie the folded sail will be placed into the grading box and when the competitors feel it is properly stored will call out stowed and raise their hands in the air.

5.6 Timers will start timing when the competitors touch the sail and stop when the competitor is hands free and announces stowed.

5.7 Low time shall be used.

5.8 For each side of the box the sail touches once stowed a 10 second penalty will be awarded.

5.9 The fastest time minus penalties of the three attempts are the competitor's score.

5.10 In the event of a tie a single fold off will continue until a single placeholder is resolved.

5.11 Competitors will be scored in their respective classes. The top three overall winners will be awarded medals in each class.

6. PROTESTS

RC will hear all protests.

7. SCORING & FLEETS

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System will apply in the Regatta. This will count as Race #5.

8. AWARDS

Centennial Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be given out to the top three winners in each class.
