

# 1923 - 2023 CCYC Centennial Celebration Centennial Regatta Race 2 Corpus Christi Yacht Club Corpus Christi, Texas November 7 - 12, 2023 Posted 11/6/23 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - MONKEY FIST TOSS

### 1. RULES

1.1 This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, rules of the South Texas PHRF, the Notice of Regatta, and these Sailing Instructions. If said rules are contradicted in any way by these Sailing Instructions, then these Sailing Instructions are controlling.

### 2. ENTRIES

Any PHRF Yacht registered to compete in the Centennial Regatta is eligible to compete. One (1) member of each PHRF competing yacht is required to participate to be awarded points.

# 3. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Any amendments to the Sailing Instructions will either be posted on Regatta Network, CCYC Lanai.
- 3.2 The Race Committee (RC) reserves the right to also amend the Sailing Instructions orally if necessary.

### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Close of registration will be 1700 hours on Tuesday November 7, 2023 competition will began after a competitors meeting to review the rules and scoring.
- 7.2 Each Competitor will have until 1800 to complete three (3) throws. Best throw will be used. No practice throws.
- 7.3 Competitor may choose to make all throws at one time or single throws following the rotation.

### 5. RULES AND SCORING

- 5.1 Official certified Regatta Monkey Toss line SHALL BE USED.
- 5.2 Competitors will have 1 hour to complete the three throws.
- 5.3 Scores will be based on overall distance minus distance from centerline.

(60ft throw three feet from centerline = 57 score)

- 5.4 In the event of a tie a single throw off will continue until a single placeholder is resolved.
- 5.5 Competitors will be scored and awarded medals in their respective classes.

### 6. PROTESTS

RC will hear all protests.

# 7. SCORING & FLEETS

14.1 The Low Point Scoring System will apply in the Regatta. This will count as Race #2.

# 8. AWARDS

Centennial Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be given out to the top three winners in each class.
