SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - SAIL HOIST

1. RULES

This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, rules of the South Texas PHRF, the Notice of Regatta, and these Sailing Instructions. If said rules are contradicted in any way by these Sailing Instructions, then these Sailing Instructions are controlling.

2. ENTRIES

Any PHRF Yacht registered to compete in the Centennial Regatta is eligible to compete. One (1) member of each PHRF competing yacht is required to participate to be awarded points.

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on Regatta Network and/or CCYC Lanai.

3.2 The Race Committee (RC) reserves the right to also amend the Sailing Instructions orally if necessary.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 Close of registration will be 1700 hours on Thursday November 9, 2023 competition will begin after a competitors meeting to review the rules and scoring.

4.2 Each Competitor will have until 1800 to complete two (2) attempts. Best attempt will be used. No practice attempts.

5. RULES AND SCORING

5.1 Gin pole on L Head will be used with official regatta sail.

5.2 Competitors will have 1 hour to complete two attempts.

5.3 Competitors will start with the sail on the deck (ground) and the halyard uncleated and untouched.

5.4 Time will start when the competitor touches the halyard.

5.5 Competitor will hoist the sail until snug and securing the halyard to the cleat. Once complete the competitor will release the halyard, yell “MADE” AND hold their arms in the air.

5.6 The timers will start timing when the halyard is touched by the competitor and stop when they hear the “MADE” call AND the hands are in the air.

5.7 The fastest time recorded on each attempt is the competitor’s time.

8.5 In the event of a tie a single hoist off will continue until a single placeholder is resolved.

8.6 Competitors will be scored in their respective classes. Only top three overall winners will be awarded medals in each class.

6. PROTESTS

RC will hear all protests.

7. SCORING & FLEETS

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System will apply in the Regatta. This will count as Race #4.

11. AWARDS

Centennial Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be given out to the top three winners in each class.
