1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to the Bitter Ends, Bow Chasers, Broad Reachers, Dinghy Dames, Luffing Lassies, Mainsheet Mamas, Rhumb Runners, Salty Sisters, St Augustine Sailing Sisters, Windlasses and individual members of FWSA.
This regatta shall be sailed in 420s (non-spinnaker).
- 2.2 Ten rental boats are available for practice sessions and the regatta.
Clubs have one boat reserved for each of the 10 clubs.
- 2.3 There is no limit to the number of personal 420s (non-spinnaker).
- 2.4 Register on Regatta Network by Thursday October 26, 2023.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$55.00 per boat. Paid on Regatta Network website.
- 3.2 Boat rental fee \$60/per boat. Paid on Regatta Network website.
No boat fees if a club brings their own boat.
- 3.3 Damage deposit of \$250. A check may be written to DYSA.

- 3.4 Lunch fee is \$17/individual payable on Regatta Network.
Lunch orders are due by Thursday November 2 @ 1200 hours.

All lunches will consist of a large sandwich, fruit, potato chips, cookies and a drink.

Lunch choices:

- A. Sunny Bird – sliced turkey, cream cheese, sunflower seeds, sprouts, mayo & honey French dressing
- B. Nutty Chicken Salad – Diced Tyson chicken with red grapes, almonds, Celery, lettuce and mayo.
- C. Roast beef – thinly sliced roast beef with sweet onions, mayo, lettuce and homemade horseradish sauce.
- D. Pressed Cuban – Ham, pork, salami, swiss cheese, pickles and spicy mustard.
- E. Custom Vegetarian-Swiss cheese or cream cheese, cucumbers, alfalfa Sprouts, sweet onion, lettuce, tomatoes, mayo, black olives and Italian or French dressing.

4.7 First warning signal for 1st Race 1000 hours.

4.8 No warning signal after 1430 hours.

6. Venue

The regatta will be sailed from Dunedin Boat Club, 49 Main St, Dunedin, FL 34698.

Racing will be in North St. Joseph's Sound, north of the clubhouse.

7. The Course

The course to be sailed will be windward/off-set with leeward gate.

8. Scoring

8.1 A minimum of 8 registered boats for hosting the regatta.

8.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

- 8.3 Three races are scheduled.
8.4 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

9. Awards

- 9.1 8 - 10 boat entries, top three places shall be awarded.
9.2 11 or more entries, top four places shall be awarded.



- 9.3 The perpetual trophy will be awarded.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, disease, or illness in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. Safety

All sailors must comply with Coast Guard regulations: have a whistle and wearable PFD. Please bring your own water container.

12. COVID-19 Safety Guidelines – (to be changed as appropriate)

- 12.1 All participants should take their temperature at home; if temperature is 100.4 or higher, Stay home!
12.2 If you or someone in your household has had flu-like symptoms in the past week, stay home.
