
2024 A Class North Americans Request for Redress and Rule 69 Report April 1, 2024
 1. This is a formal RRS 69.2b request to present evidence before the first race day of April 9 supporting allegations that the excluders committed Rule 69 infractions of Bullying, Unethical Behavior, and Unsportsmanlike Conduct for illegally denying my participation in twelve Championships and for denying the entry of people associated with me. No one has offered evidence to refute my allegations after numerous reports. By illegally denying entry, the discriminators have brought the sport into disrepute by staging twelve "championships" where eligible contenders were denied entry and by crushing the aspirations of juniors. The US Sailing "Role of the Championship Host" includes; "Complies with US Sailing's ZERO Tolerance policy for abuse and misconduct under the Safe Sport guidelines. This includes not only on-water safety, but also safety ashore throughout the event" The unwarranted rejections are an example of abuse and misconduct and if they want to be in compliance, Pensacola Yacht Club must hold the excluders accountable to prevent more illegal exclusions. As Zoom hearings have proven to be unproductive, Monday afternoon, April 8 is the day before racing when parties and witnesses can physically appear in a hearing to resolve this once and for all. Any hearing scheduled after Monday evening would wrongfully deny my opportunity to prepare for the races and would constitute an illegal denial of due process
