

Bluster Regatta Notice of Race

Indian River Lagoon, Downtown Melbourne

January 12, 13 & 14, 2024

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2021 – 2024 *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and class rules.*

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all classes of boats including A-Cat (Classics and Foilers), Hobie 14, 16, 17, 18, 20, and Wave, F16, F18, Nacra 15/17/Carbon 20, Weta and **OPEN** classes.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter online through the Regatta Network website by December 31st, 2023; OA has the right but not the obligation to allow later registrations.
- 3.3. All A Cat competitors must be paid A class members and in good standing of their class association.
- 3.4. Any HCA or FWC legal boat constitutes the Wave class.
- 3.5. Entries after December 31 may be accepted with a \$25 late fee and stern talking.

4. Fees

- 4.1. Required Fees:
Doublehanded boats until 0000 on December 31, 2023: \$150 (\$175 afterward)
Singlehanded boats until 0000 on December 31, 2023: \$115 (\$140 after 1/3/23)

5. Schedule (tentative)

900 – 1100 – Registration

1030 – Competitors' meeting

1200 – First warning signal (3-5 races scheduled each race day, tba)

1700-1800 – (Social planned, TBA)

Saturday, January 13th

1100 – First warning signal

1700 -2200 – Food provided onsite Melbourne Yacht Club via food truck. Beer available at the park post racing.

Sunday, January 15th

1000 – First warning signal

1400 – No initial warning signal for a new race after this time

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. Sailing instructions will be available online by January 10, 2024, on Regatta Network. To reduce paper waste, copies will be available onsite only on request.
- 6.2. Online sailing instructions may be changed until 1800 Thursday, January 11, without a posted amendment.

7. Venue

- 7.1. Racing will take place in the Indian River Lagoon, on Florida's Space Coast, Brevard County, 1 mile South of the US192 Causeway.
- 7.2. The regatta venue is Riverview Park, launched from "Scurrah's Landing", Downtown Melbourne, (Indian River Lagoon, On Florida's Space Coast).

8. Penalty System

- 8.1. For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2. if 5 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races scores, excluding the competitors worse score.

10. Radio Communications

- 10.1. Competitors are strongly encouraged to carry personal VHF radios to monitor race committee communications. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing

shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

11. Prizes

11.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority

12. Disclaimer of Liability

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. Insurance

13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent. Proof of insurance required at registration.
