	SER 2.4.4 – Lifelines -Required. Existing factory installation is satisfactory.
	SER 2.5.1 - Primary Operating Bilge Pump - Required. Currently installed
-	bilge pump/switching/draining/capacity satisfactory.
	SER 3.6.2, 3.6.6 – Flares - All yachts must meet the USCG flare requirements
	(SOLAS certification recommended).
	SER 3.16.2 – EPIRB/PLB -Not required but recommended.
	SER 3.31 – All Specified Gear Identification – Not required but recommended.
	SER 3.33.1 – Boats shall have a means to reduce main sail area - (Currently
	used method & reduction percentage satisfactory).
	SER 4.3.2 – Safety at Sea training – Not required but highly recommended.
	The Organizing Authority strongly recommends that all competitors
	take the opportunity to attend an upcoming <u>Seminar</u> .
