NOTICE OF RACE

February 17-18, 2024



The Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta is Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA); https://scyamidwinterregatta.org/ Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club (CBYC) will host and provide race management for the 2024 SCYA Midwinter Regatta for Mercury, International 14 and Melges 15 classes. Club info at https://cbyc.org.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official Regatta Notice Board is in the portico at the main entrance to CBYC clubhouse. Class rules shall apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to all OD boat members of SCYA or USSA recognized yacht clubs and must be members in good standing of their Class Association.

CLASSES: Mercury, International 14 and Melges 15 with at least five entries per class.

RACE SCHEDULE: Three or more races on Saturday and two or more races on Sunday are planned weather and time permitting. One race completed as a minimum shall constitute the series. All races count toward the final score, no throw-out races. <u>This changes *RRS* A2.1</u> The first warning signal of each day will be at 1225 hours. No race will start after 1500 hours on Sunday.

RACING AREA: The racing area will be inside the San Pedro upper breakwater, approximately 0.7 nautical mile SE of Cabrillo Marina.

SAILORS MEETING: A sailors meeting will be held on Saturday, February 17 at the CBYC Dry Storage yard at 1000 hours.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions, plus any posted supplements, will be available online at the Regatta Network website listed below by 1800 hrs. on February 16, 2024.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard following each day of racing.

ENTRIES & FEES: Entries are online with Regatta Network at the following website: https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27255 All entries must be filed by 1800 hours on Friday, February 16, 2024. The entry fee is as set by SCYA and posted on the registration website.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists of up to 6,000 pounds capacity and a 14' wide dinghy ramp are available at the CBYC dry storage facility located along Via Cabrillo adjacent to the main clubhouse.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the regatta, based on the entries, in the CBYC dining room.

ACTIVITIES: Competitors and guests are welcome to use the CYBC facilities during the event. Bar Food will be available after racing in upstairs bar area.
