NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: HCANA (Division 7) Fleet 474

Venue: [Marble Beach, State Recreation Area](#), 12320 240th Ave, Spirit Lake IA 51360
Event is held at the campground and beach at this location.

Rules: A FLEET: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the International Hobie Class Association (IHCA) Class rules. **In accordance with RRS 87, the IHCA has granted this event an exemption to the provisions of IHCA General Rule 16.5 so that trampolines from any manufacturer may be used during the event.** RRS Rule 44 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

B FLEET (novice fleet): The regatta will be governed by both the IHCA Class rules and the Formula Wave Class (FWC) rules.

Radio Communication: Sailors may carry a VHF radio. Use and restrictions will be described in the Sailing Instructions (SIs).

Classes: The regatta is open to all class legal Hobie Waves as listed above in the Rules section.

Eligibility: All competitors shall be members of the Hobie Class Association at the time of the event.

Insurance: Each team must show proof of \$100,000 USD liability insurance at registration or via Regatta Network.

Registration: All registrations must be completed on Regatta Network. A registration is not complete until paid in full.
