Rules: A FLEET: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Hobie Class Association (HCA) Class rules. In accordance with RRS 87, the IHCA has granted this event an exemption to the provisions of IHCA General Rule 16.5 so that trampolines from any manufacturer may be used during the event. RRS Rule 44 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

B FLEET (novice fleet): The regatta will be governed by both the HCA Class rules and the Formula Wave Class (FWC) rules.

Radio Communication: Sailors may carry a VHF radio. Use and restrictions will be described in the Sailing Instructions (SIs).

Classes: The regatta is open to all class legal Hobie Waves as listed above in the Rules section.
