 - o 10:00am Beach check in at race headquarters near barrel 64 o 10:30am Skippers Meeting Starting place draw o 12:00pm Warning Signal for first start, additional starts at 5 min. intervals o If time and weather permits, there may be an additional race for all classes on the Rig Course
 - o Awards presented approx. 30 min. after the last boat finishes on the beach
- Two courses with spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes each. Trophies awarded to top finishers as determined by number of entrants in each class.
 - o Rig Course approx. 5 nm
 - o Wreck Course approx. 14 nm

- Boats must have valid SCHRS (Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System) rating; modifications are allowed with appropriate adjustment to rating base. Please indicate all modifications on your registration. Non-class sails requires sail maker documentation of measurement to be submitted to the PRO by August 8, 2024 by email to racinbill@gmail.com
- Single handed teams must obtain approval from PRO prior to registering, No exceptions.
- Le Mans style start off the beach and finish line on the beach.
- Early registration: \$60 by August 1, 2024 5:00pm CST. Late registration: \$75 after this date (t-shirts will not be available). Deadline for registration is Friday August 9, 2024 at 1:00pm, Absolutely no new entries will be accepted the day of the race.
- Registration must be completed online at Regattanetwork.com. Follow the link at https://www.regattanetwork.com. All registrations must be made online.
 - o Competitors are not officially entered until payment has been received by the August 9th entry deadline.
- All teams are strongly urged to register prior to August 1, 2024 5:00pm CST. Registrations later than that date are not guaranteed t-shirts.
- T-shirts for skipper and crew if registered in the early registration period.
- Additional t-shirts available for purchase at \$25 each. Shirt orders must be placed no later than August1st.
- All boats must have liability insurance coverage and complete the Release Waiver online through Regatta Network
- Due to regatta insurance requirements, this will be a Hobie Class Association North America (HCANA) sanctioned event and at least one crew person per boat is required to be a member of the HCANA. Temporary event membership is available for \$30 at https://hcana.hobieclass.com/join/

- o REQUIRED EQUIPMENT
- o <u>LIFE PRESERVERS</u>, One (1) certified personal floatation device capable of supporting their full weight shall be worn by each person on board whileracing.
- o MOBILE PHONE in a waterproof bag. Batteries should be fully charged.
- o TOW LINE min. 30ft long
- o RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT
- o <u>HANDHELD MARINE VHF RADIO manufacturer rated "Submersible" or inwaterproof bag with lanyard. Batteries should be fully charged. It is highlyrecommended that one be secured as personal gear to each sailor.</u>
- o GPS manufacturer rated "Submersible" or in waterproof bag with lanyard.Batteries should be fully charged.
- o <u>KNIFE</u> each sailor should carry a knife or cutting device as personal gearwhich is to be used for self-rescue purposes.
- See Sailing Instructions for race details posted on Regatta Network Race Documents no later than August 8. Emails will be sent through Regatta Network notifying document postings and any race updates provided your email address has been supplied with registration information. Note: copies of the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions will not be available on the beach.
- Decision to Race, Racing Rules of Sailing 3— Competitors participate in this race entirely at their own risk. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this event.
