NOTICE OF RACE D.J.JOHNSON AROUND OAHU REGATTA

May 25th, 26th & 27th, 2024

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association (HYRA) and Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.1.1.Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches. The use of steering vanes and/or autopilot is authorized for single and double-handed crews only
 - 1.2.1. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
 - 1.2.2.Redress: RRS 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
 - 1.2.3. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 2. **ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations. Eliqible boats are required to register through regatta network. Please refer to:

- 4. **CLASSES:** Boats will be scored in X, A, B, Cruising & Multihull.
- 5. FEES: The entry fee will be \$75.00 (includes \$15 HYRA fee)

- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network
- 8. VENUE: The waters around the island of Oahu.
- 9. COURSES: Day 1 Waikiki to Kaneohe

Day 2 – Kaneohe to Haleiwa Day 3 – Kahe Point to Waikiki

More detailed course information will be in the sailing instructions.

10. SCORING: RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

- 11. MOORING: It will be each entrant's responsibility where to secure their boat on the first and second day (e.g., Kaneohe Bay, Haleiwa, Pokai Bay, Ko Olina). For Day One, please contact the KYC Port Captain (mtib70@hotmail.com) at least 2 weeks prior to the event for a spot at KYC.
- 12. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented for A, B, Cruising & Multihull at the awards ceremony
