The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RS 40.1 shall apply while crew are on the water. RS 40.2 is deleted.
- 1.3 The NCPHRF Part 1: Rules and Guidelines shall apply to boats racing in the PHRF divisions. These can be found at: http://yra.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/RulesAnd-GuidelinesJan_2022.pdf
- 1.4 The use of powered equipment is permitted as long as boats have declared this information on their PHRF certificate. This modifies Rule 52.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available by 1500 hrs on Thursday, March 7th at the Richmond Yacht Club and on the Richmond Yacht Club website.
- 2.2 PHRF and one design division assignments will be posted on the RYC website after 1500 hrs. on Thursday, March 7th.

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located in the race room at RYC and online at: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27490>
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels used by racing on the bay.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Saturday Fleet Racing regatta is open to PHRF boats with valid NCPHRF certificates with a rating of 280 and below and One Design monohulled keelboats. One design fleets with greater than 5 entries may be given a one-design start.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter the event by registering online at: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27490>
- 4.3 Entry deadline is 1800 hrs on Thursday, March 07, 2024.
- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee for Saturday is \$2.85 per foot.

6 SCHEDULE

Race 1	1125 hrs
Race 2	Immediately following Race #1
Race 3	Immediately following Race #2

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The racing area Saturday will be on three courses, Southampton, Olympic Circle, and Deep Water (southwest of the Olympic Circle).
- 7.2 Racing will be around temporary marks. The deep water course may use some YRA buoys.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The scoring system is as follows: PHRF time allowances shall be calculated using the Time on Time (TOT) method.
- 8.2 Three races are scheduled. All races will count toward the final score. This changes RRS A2.
- 8.3 PHRF scoring will be used for the purpose of awarding overall prizes.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to first through third place finishers in each class with more than 6 boats, and to first and second place finishers for 5 boats.
- 9.2 The trophy presentation will be held on the RYC deck after the racing on Saturday, March 9th.

10 INSURANCE

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
