2. AED Defibrillators

Located in the Bar and are clearly marked. Please ask FWBC Staff Member for assistance.

3. Safety boat and resources on the water

EVERY spectator and support vessel will be informed of the safety plan, is expected to serve as additional safety, and should have a basic first aid kit.

4. Medical emergencies on the water

If required the casualty should be taken to the fuel dock in Fort Worth Boat Club harbor, advise the race committee on the designated channel for assistance.

5. Severe life threatening injury

For example: head injury with loss of consciousness, severe bleeding, drowning or if any doubt.

- Call 911
- Hail Race Committee on VHF

- If it is safe to do so transfer the victims to the first aid boat or the fastest available boat for transport.
- Proceed to EMS ambulance pick up location at Fort Worth Boat Club.
- Notify on-shore safety and contacts.

6. Severe non-life threatening injuries:

For example: severe cuts, broken bones, head injuries when the victim is still conscious.

- Hail Race Committee on VHF
- If it is safe to do so transfer the victims to the first aid boat or the fastest available boat for transport
- Proceed to Fort Worth Boat Club on-shore First Aid station.
- Notify on shore safety and contacts.

7. Weather monitoring

In the case of a storm, the race committee will communicate a suspension of racing and that boats should return to Fort Worth Boat Club.
