### 2010 NOTICE OF RACE/ SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### MASTERS' RACE (Revised 2/25/10 Rajacich)

- 1 RULES Race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing unless any of these are changed by these sailing instructions.
- 2 ELIGIBILITY Skippers are required to be T.A.Y.C. members in good standing and have reached the age of 60 years or more. Boats must have and race under a valid PHRF rating. If the boat does not have a PHRF of the Chesapeake rating, she may use an "OARS" rating.
- 3 ENTRIES Entries taken on TAYC's online registration ONLY. See [tayc.com/racing](http://tayc.com/racing) for registration form. There is no entry fee. Deadline for registration is 0930 hrs Sept 4, 2010. Late fees are \$25.
- 4 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS Announcements and changes to the race instructions, if any, will be posted on the official race notice bulletin board located in the Club lobby.
- 5 SCHEDULE OF RACE

\*RRS 26- An alert signal will sound approximately 1 min prior to the warning gun. PHRF NON-SPINNAKER (single head sail only unless changing)
- 6 COURSE The course will be displayed at the end of the floating dock. Choptank Area Standard Racing Marks, will be signaled as indicated in the CBYRA Greenbook, and attached to this notice.
- 7 MARKS G "1" off Benoni Pt. must always be honored and passed to seaward. Rounding marks are designated on the sheet marked Choptank Area Standard Racing Marks.
- 8 STARTING Between the orange starting mark and orange flag on signal staff of Race Committee 2nd deck.
- 9 TIME LIMIT four (4) hours
- 10 FINISH Between orange flag on 2<sup>nd</sup> deck and R "2" (area mark "N"). Yachts withdrawing must notify Race Committee promptly. Race may be shortened at any turning mark or at the finish line without prior notice required by rule 32.1.
- 11 PROTESTS Written protests must be delivered to the day's Race Officer within 20 minutes of finishing race or race committee boat arriving at the dock. Forms may be obtained from Race Committee or Club Manager.
- 12 SCORING The Low Point Scoring System will apply. One race is scheduled.
- 13 AWARDS Trophies will be awarded per the Tred Avon Yacht Club trophy policy at the Club following the race.
- 14 RADIO Yachts are invited to monitor VHF channel 71.
