Rules0

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be posted at the office of Lighthouse Landing Resort & Marina, no later than Friday, May 17, 2024.
- 2.2 Amendments to the sailing instruction will be posted at Lighthouse Landing Resort& Marina, 320 W Commerce Avenue, Grand Rivers, KY 42045

Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The Regatta will be opened to all cruisers or racers/cruisers properly registered with Lighthouse Landing Resort & Marina and have the proper safety equipment.
- 3.2 Potential Classes
- a. Spinnaker any boat equipped with intent to fly a spinnaker
- b. JAM A -Jib and main only, PHRF 179 and below

- c. JAM B Jib and main only, PHRF 180 and above
- d. One Design Any one design with 3 or more boats

Racing

- 4.1 The Regatta will be a distance race of approximately similes on Kentucky Lake approximately 25 miles
- 4.2 The course will start/finish at mile marker 23 (across the channel from Lighthouse Landing Resort & Marina and turning mark will be Redd's Light at mile 10.6 (36'42 762).

 The turning mark will be approximately Sugar Bay with more information at the captains meeting
- 4.3 The race may be shortened the Race Committe at any time, until the first boat in, its class has reached the southern turning mark

Scoring

- 5.1 PHRF wind dependent, time on time
- 5.2 Time correction = 700(F + PHRF), F=650 light winds (3-8), F=550 Moderate wind (8-12), F=450 heavy wind (13-25)

Prizes

- 6.1 Trophies will be awarded to the first three (3) in each class
- 6.2 A Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the best overall correct time
- 6.3 A First to Finish Trophy will be awarded to the first boat to finish the race.

Safety

7.1 All boats shall have USCG required equipment along with a VHF radio and navigation

light in working condition
