Organizing Authority: Hobie Fleet 416 and Hobie Class Association of North America

Rules: Racing shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Hobie Class Association. Competitors are reminded that per IHCA class rule 26, **at least one crew member per boat shall be a paid member of the Hobie Class Association.**

Eligibility and Entry: This event is open to all class legal Hobie Waves, Hobie 14's, Hobie 16's, Hobie 17's, and Hobie 18's; for an example of what class legal means: Wave sails must be Hobie-branded.

Fees:

Double handed: \$ 80 Single handed: \$ 70

Youth: free; Youth are defined as all crew under the age of 21 on 31 December 2024. HCANA membership will be paid for first time skippers. If requested, help will be available to assist inexperienced skippers on Saturday morning prior to racing and Friday evening.
