NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (referred to as "RRS") and the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments or supplements thereto.
- 1.2 The number of fleets in the regatta will be determined based on the number of boats registered in the regatta on or before April 1, 2024.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all PHRF and One Design keelboats, subject to the following restriction:

All PHRF boats must have a current or provisional Lake Ray Hubbard PHRF rating. If the boat has not been rated, submit pertinent information to the Lake Ray Hubbard PHRF committee to have a provisional rating assigned. Please note to adjust your rating based on your using a spinnaker.

If you need assistance with your boat's current or provisional rating, please contact Laura Garner (lm.garner@yahoo.com) or Sean Teele (sean.teele@yahoo.com) when you register.

Deadline to submit pertinent information is April 1, 2024.

2.2 All boats must have only two sailors on board

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on Regatta Network. Any supplements or amendments to the sailing instructions will also be posted on Regatta Network.

6 VENUE

Races will be sailed on Lake Ray Hubbard, south of I-30.

7 THE COURSES

Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions. Races will be started in accordance with Rule 26 of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 There will be at least one and up to four races if time and weather allows. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 (a) A boat's score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) Refer to Sailing Instructions and RRS for more information about scoring.
 - (c) Finish places will be determined with adjustments for each boat's PHRF rating.

9 PRIZES

Trophies will be award to both sailors on the boat awarded for first, second and third finishing places for each class with five or more boats entered. If the class has four or fewer boats entered, trophies will be awarded for first and second finishing places.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors and participants participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3 Decision to Race and RRS 4 Acceptance of the Rules and the Sailing Instructions and any amendments or supplements thereto. The organizing authority, race committee, and regatta committee will not accept any liability for material

damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

All skippers are required to inform their crew members and participants on her boat of the dangers of participating and the disclaimer of liability.
