1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

American Legion Yacht Club (ALYC), 215 15th St. Newport Beach CA 92663 is the organizing authority for the 2022 Sundowner Series.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The series will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the fleet in which a boat is racing.
- 2.2. Symmetrical or asymmetrical spinnakers are NOT allowed.

3. CLASSES

- 3.1 PHRF rated boats are invited to race.
- 3.2 Boats without a current PHRF Certificate are invited to race and will be assigned to a class by the Race Committee (R/C),
- 3.2 Boats without a PHRF Certificate are required to submit a completed Rating Form (Appendix A) to the R/C Chair via email race@alyc.com no later than forty eight hours before the race.
- 3.3 The R/C may assign a boat to a class that they deem to be appropriate.

4. ENTRIES AND FEES

- 4.1 Online entry is available at www.alyc.com through Regatta Network.
- 4.2 The entry fee is \$30.00 and you may enter at anytime before April 27th, but early registration is strongly encouraged.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 5:00pm the day prior to the race and will be posted to the ALYC's website www.alyc.com through Regatta Network.
- 5.2 A race packet including the SI's and Newport Harbor map will be available at the Skippers meeting/Seminar on April 27th

7. SCHEDULE

- 7.1 1000 - 1030 Check in at ALYC 215 15th St, Newport Beach
- 1030 - 1130 Skipper meeting & Seminar - Into to Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1255 - Scheduled First Warning
- 1500 - Approximate end of racing meet back at ALYC for Award presentation, discussion, food and prizes
- 7.2 Two random leg races are scheduled.
- 7.3 Any changes to the schedule will be posted by 1900 the day before the race on the

ALYC website through Regatta Network.

8. PRIZES

8.1 Prize for first place, will be awarded for each race

8.2 Prizes for the series first, second and third place will be awarded.

9. COURSES TO BE SAILED

9.1 Courses will be posted on the race committee boat.

9.2 The Start and Finish line will be in Newport Harbor in the "Five-Points" area.

10. SCORING

10.1 Boats shall be scored based on their finish place, using RRS Appendix A.

The time of a boat's starting signal shall be her starting time, and the order in which boats finish a race shall determine their finishing places. However, when a handicap or rating system is used a boat's corrected time shall determine her finishing place.

10.2 A boats series score shall be the combined score of both races

10.3 There will be no throw-outs, this modifies RRS Appendix A
