

MILES RIVER YACHT CLUB 2024 Junior Sail Regatta NOTICE OF RACE August 8th, 2024



- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. **ELIGIBILITY**: The regatta is open to all boats in the Club 420, Laser Radial, and Opti Green, Red, White, and Blue classes.

Age: Sailors may only compete if (a) they will not have their twentieth (20th) birthday during the calendar year of the regatta AND (b) they have not competed in any collegiate sailing event prior to the regatta.

Compensation: As this is an amateur regatta held in the Corinthian spirit of competition, sailors may not compete as skipper or crew if they are or will be paid or otherwise compensated for participating in the regatta. By registering for the regatta, each sailor affirms that neither they nor their crew is being paid nor otherwise compensated for competing.

- 3. ENTRIES: Registration is available online at regattanetwork.com/event/27960
- 4. REGISTRATION FEE: \$ 25 for one-person boats, \$50 for C420s. The fee includes after the regatta a hot dog buffet, snow cones, watermelon, and the pool Late fees apply two days or less before the regatta.



- **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be provided at Registration. They may also be posted on the event site and at www.milesriveryc.org when available.
- **7. VENUE**: The race area will be Long Haul Creek next to the Yacht Club and the adjacent Miles River. See the next page for **PARKING** information.
- 8. **SCORING**: The low-point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. One completed race shall constitute a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores unless (4) four or more races are completed, in which case she may exclude her worst score.
- **9. LAUNCHING**: Hoist, beach, and ramp launching are available. Dry storage is available in the Club field. Boat wash down/cleaning is available in the Club field.
- **10. PRIZES**: Awards will be given for 1st-3rd for C420, Laser Radial, and Opti White, Blue, and Red. In addition, 1st 3rd will be awarded overall in the Opti fleet. Awards will be given to the top girl competitors in the Laser radial, Opti red, white, and blue, and the top all-girl C420 team. Participation awards will be given to all Green fleet sailors. The Organizing Authority may award additional prizes and giveaways.
