1st Race of PBYC's Island Series & 2nd Race of SBYC's Wilson Series

SANTA BARBARA TO VENTURA HARBOR

The Race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
Course Spinnaker A is designated Coastal and Courses Spinnaker B, Non-Spinnaker, & Multihull are designated Nearshore level as modified: add USSER Coastal 2.4.1 - 2.4.7, 2.4.4 coated lifelines OK.

SPINNAKER A

(Around Santa Cruz Island, 67 nm)

Minimum 5 boats.
PHRF membership required. (Area random leg rating).

SPINNAKER B

(Around Anacapa Island, 47 nm)

PHRF membership required. (Area random leg rating).

NON-SPINNAKER

(Around platforms C, Habitat, & Grace, 29 nm)

PHRF membership required *in order to be eligible to win trophies*. (Area random leg rating).

MULTI-HULL

(Around Anacapa Island, 47 nm)

ORCATCF ratings will be used.

HARDWAY CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

The places of the top three PHRF Spinnaker boats from each club will be totaled and the club with the lowest points will be awarded the Hardway Race Club Championship trophy.

HARDWAY RACE OVERALL WINNER TROPHY

This perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all PHRF classes sailing the Hardway course around Santa Cruz.

HARDWAY RACE FIRST TO FINISH TROPHY

This perpetual trophy will be awarded to the first boat to finish the Hardway course around Santa Cruz.

NON-SPINNAKER PERPETUAL TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all boats sailing the Non-Spinnaker course.

SPINNAKER PERPETUAL TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all boats sailing the Spinnaker course.

The Hardway Race, Milt Ingram Trophy Race, and Tri-point Ocean Race have been hosted by PBYC for over three decades. Each race uses one of our Channel Islands as a mark of the course. The Island Series combines these races into one event, giving racers a prestigious series of competition and our Sponsors exposure throughout the summer. Each race can be entered individually. The NOR for each race is included herein.

Boats must enter all three races to be scored for the Island Series. The Island Series is a three-race series with no throw-outs. For Series scoring purposes, there are four classes: Spinnaker A for boats that race around Santa Cruz Island in the Hardway Race, Spinnaker B for boats that race around Anacapa Island in the Hardway Race, Non-spinnaker, and ORCA.

Trophies for the three individual races as well as the Island Series will be awarded at PBYC on Sunday, August 11th after the Tri-point Ocean Race.
