


2024 SUNSTROKE SERIES

The Organizing Authority (OA) is South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club.



NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising shall be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitors may be required to display graphics on the side of their hulls; these graphics will be supplied by the OA.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to one-design dinghies.
- 3.2 Membership in the one design class association is required.
- 3.3 Classes have been established for Lido 14, Coronado 15, Snipes, and Lasers. Other classes anticipated to participate are the Melges 15, Wasp, and Optimists. Other dinghy classes are welcome, please contact the Series Chairman with questions.
- 3.4 US Sailing Membership is encouraged.
- 3.5 To be eligible to compete in any race of the series, competitors must complete and sign an Entry Form at RegattaNetowkr.com and pay the fee prior to 1700 of the evening in which they first compete. Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.
- All boat must adhere to their class rules. OA does not require pre-race inspection or measurement certificates. Adherence to class rules shall be self policing and any problems with class rules shall be managed by the fleet captain of the class in question. No protests will be heard by the RC and the OA will make any needed adjustments only if requested by the fleet captain.

4. REGISTRATION

4.1 Registration will be via Regatta Network. use QR code or go to http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/27995

5. FEES

- 5.1 The series entry fee is \$110 for single-handed classes and \$130 for double-handed classes
- 5.2 The entry fee for each evening is \$20
- 5.3 For competitors under 18 years of age, the series entry fee is \$45 for single-handed classes and \$60 for double-handed classes.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The Series will be every Thursday night, starting May 2, 2024, and the final night on September 5th, with 19 nights of racing.
- 6.2 First Start will be at 1800 hours each Thursday.
- 6.3 Class starting order will be established on the water by the RC. Established classes in 3.3 or other

classes with at least 3 boats will get their own start. RC may combine classes at their discretion.

6.4 RC will target to run five (5) races each night. RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races. The OA may adjust start times earlier for late August and September to allow for earlier sunsets.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions and Sunstroke Series Course Chart will be available at SCCYC beginning Thursday, May 2, and may be posted at www.sccyc.org and Regattanetwork.com by April 25th.

8. VENUE

8.1 The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey breakwater, just west of the UCLA sailing center

9. COURSES

9.1 Courses will be primarily windward / leeward selected from the 2024 Sunstroke Series Course Chart.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 Each night of the series will be scored using the Low Point System.
- 10.2 A boat's one-design class series score will be determined using the Low Point System using the results of each week as a single score with three throw-outs.
- 10.3 Overall regatta champion will be determined using the High Point System. See the SIs for details.

11. MEDIA RIGHTS

11.1 By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1 Results for each evening will be announced at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing. Trophies for the series will be awarded on Thurs, September 5th.
- 12.2 Perpetuals awarded for:
 - Overall Series Winner
 - Lido Series Class Winner
 - C15 Series Class Winner
