1. RULES

Ocean Springs Yacht Club

Hosted by: Formula Wave Class

- **1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2.** RRS 60.1(a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership.
- **1.3.** The first sentence of RRS A2 is changed to read "Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores except when 5 or more races have been scored, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score".
- **1.4.** US Sailing Prescriptions to Rule 63.2 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, AND PLACEMENT

- **2.1.** This event is open to members of Formula Wave Class Association.
- 2.2. Contestants may join the class by paying their yearly dues at the regatta prior to the start of racing.
- **2.3.** The Formula Wave Class, at its sole discretion, determine eligibility and placement within divisions.

5. MEASUREMENT

- **5.1.** Each boat shall conform to the FWC class rules.
- **5.2.** All sails will be measured before the beginning of racing to conform with class rules. No measurement needed if sail was previously measured, marked, and recored.
- **5.3.** Only one sail may be used during the regata. If a competitor's sail is damaged beyond repair, they may appeal to the Organizing Authority to substitute another measured and approved sail.
- **5.4.** A boat and/or its equipment may be inspected, or directed to a place for inspection, at any time for compliance with Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race.
- **5.5** Each boat shall display a bow number on the outside of each hull. No two boats shall have the same number.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **6.1.** Race packets, including Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. Sailing Instructions **MAY** be posted on Regata Network prior to regata.
- 6.2 In case of any discrepancy between the NOR and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions





7. VENUE

- **7.1.** All racing will take place on the Near Shore waters of Back Bay Biloxi near Ocean Springs shoreline (Appendix A).
- **7.2.** Primitive camping is allowed on a first come first served basis until areas is full.

8. COURSES

8.1. Per the current Rules and Bylaws of the Formula Wave Class the courses sailed will include:

Triangle Windward- Leeward and/or Windward- Leeward.

9. SCORING

- **9.1.** The Low-Point System of Appendix A will be used.
- 9.2. Also see Paragraph 1. Rules: Sec 1.3 of this NOR
- **9.3.** One race will constitute a regatta with the intension to have 12–15 races or more if conditions allow.

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

10.1. Unrestricted for all Competitors.

11. AWARDS

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th places.
- 11.2. Prizes will be awarded for First Third place Senior (over 70) division
