#### GENERAL INFORMATION

This is a 13+ mile pursuit race; each boat will be assigned a start time in minutes after the slowest rated boat starts. The assigned start time is calculated by the Race Chair and is based on the boats random leg PHRF rating or Portsmouth Rating DPN converted to a PHRF rating.

#### RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is modified to require all competitors sailing boats of less than 20 feet LOA to wear personal floatation at all times except for short periods while changing clothes.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

- 2.1 The race is open to all boats with a PHRF rating of 263 or less or a DPN of 104 or less.
- 2.2 Boats need to conform to class rules, including minimum and maximum crew weights and number of crew.

#### 3. ENTRY AND FEES

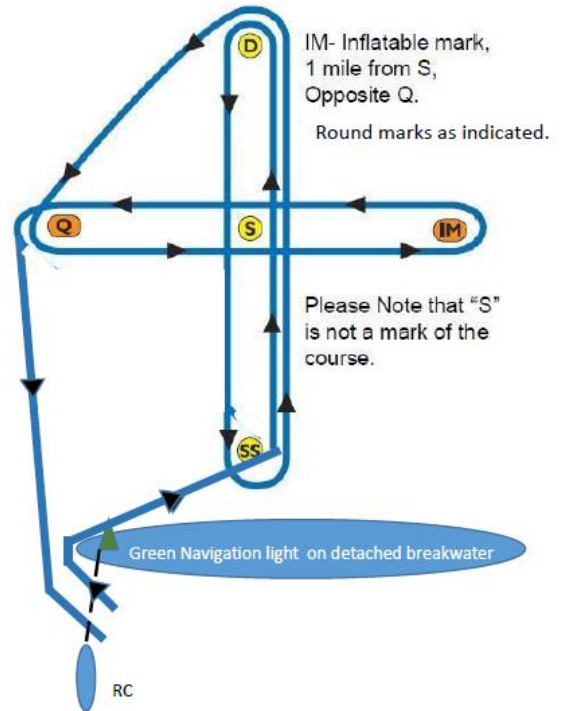
- 3.1 The entry fee is \$20.
- 3.2 Entries must be made online through [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) by 0900, the day of the race.
- 3.3 Competitors are asked provide a mobile number at the time of registration. This is to allow text messages from the organizer. Text messaging will be used to communicate start time and/or postponements. See rule 7, below
- 3.4 Competitors under the age of eighteen must have their entry signed by their parents or guardian.

#### 4. CLASSES

- 4.1 Three or more one design boats will establish a one design class.
- 4.2 Classes are mono-hull centerboards (20 feet and under), PHRF Boats and multi-hulls (20 feet and under).

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) and [www.sccyc.org](http://www.sccyc.org) web sites no later than 2000 hours on the Friday before he race.

7. **SKIPPER MEETING**

No skippers meeting. Starting times will be assigned and communicated via txt before 1000 the day of the race. When you register be sure to **tick the box to “allow text messages from the organizer.”**

8. **VENUE / COURSE**

- 8.1 The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, west of the Marina del Rey Breakwater.
- 8.2 Course will use both MDR Marks, described in [Course Chart 17](#), and orange or yellow inflatable marks.
- 8.3 The course will be approximately 13.8 miles. The rated distance will be set by the Race Committee.
- 8.4 Course details will be published with the SI.

9. **SERIES SCORING**

Boats will be scored in the order of finish.

10. **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC after the race. The Outlook Trophy will be awarded to the winner of each class with three or more boats starting in that class.

11. **DISCLAIMER**

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
